


AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$280,000) FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND BALANCE, AS OF THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 2019, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Department of Youth Affairs serves our island community with pride and dedication with the limited resources it possesses. Many of the individuals who serve as Youth Service Workers and Social Workers seek privately funded training opportunities and equipment to broaden their skills and ability to provide a level of service that is beneficial to the youth they serve. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that these men and women are often underappreciated and unrecognized for the work they perform in juvenile justice reform to help curb recidivism and improve youth outcomes that ultimately enhance community safety.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate from the unappropriated fund balance, as of the end of Fiscal Year 2019, to the Department

1 of Youth Affairs to provide for law enforcement equipment and training, and youth
2 development and facilities maintenance training.

3 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Department of Youth Affairs.** Up to the
4 sum of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000) is appropriated from the
5 unappropriated General Fund Balance, as of the end of Fiscal Year 2019, for law
6 enforcement equipment and training; and training for personnel in youth
7 development and facilities maintenance. The appropriation in this Section *shall not*
8 lapse and *shall* continue until fully expended.

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

10 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
11 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions
12 or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or
13 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
