AN ACT TO AMEND § 121802 (b)(2) AND (c)(2) OF CHAPTER 12, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO UPDATING QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSURE FOR NEW HIRE BACHELOR'S AND MASTER'S LEVEL SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY ASSISTANTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 2 that P.L. 34-48, which amended qualifications for licensure for the Bachelor's level 3 Speech-language pathology assistants and the Master's level Speech-language 4 pathology assistants, does not apply to unemployed Speech-language pathology 5 assistants. During the revision of the law, Speech-language pathology assistants who 6 were already employed were at an advantage because they had an on-site licensed 7 supervisor who could sign the Supervisor Form, which is required to be submitted 8 within three (3) working days of application or renewal pursuant to P.L. 34-48, 9 codified at 5 GCA § 121802(b)(2) and (c)(2). I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the 10 Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners is unable to approve applications submitted 11 by unemployed Speech-language pathology assistants due to the lack of a supervisor 12 who could sign the Supervisor Form. I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that 13 14 licensure is necessary for Speech-language pathology assistants who wish to practice. It is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to update the qualifications for 15

- licensure for the Bachelor's level Speech-language pathology assistants and the
- 2 Master's level Speech-language pathology assistants to allow the Supervisor Form
- 3 to be signed and submitted upon hire.
- Section 2. § 121802(b)(2) of Chapter 12, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated,
- 5 is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- 6 "(2) The SLPA-B and supervisor will complete and submit the Supervisor
- 7 Form provided by the Board upon application, or renewal, and no later than three
- 8 (3) working days upon any supervisory changes within a license renewal year;
- 9 provided, that for new hires, the Supervisor Form may be submitted within three (3)
- 10 working days and shall be submitted before performing any speech therapy
- 11 services."
- Section 3. Subsection §121802 (c) (2) of Chapter 12, Title 10, of the Guam
- 13 Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- 14 "(2) All SLPA-M and supervisor will complete and submit the Supervisor
- 15 Form provided by the Board upon application, or renewal, and no later than three
- 16 (3) working days upon any supervisory changes within a license renewal year;
- provided, that for new hires, the Supervisor Form may be submitted within three (3)
- working days upon application and shall be submitted before performing any speech
- 19 therapy services."
- Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to
- 21 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
- 22 shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
- 23 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 24 Act are severable.
