AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 AND ADD A NEW SECTION 18 TO PART II OF CHAPTER III IN PUBLIC LAW 35-36, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR THE DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the appropriation from the Environmental Health Fund in Public Law 35-36, the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget Law, was under appropriated as it relates to the mandates and the collection of fines and fees imposed for services provided by the over-worked and under-appreciated men and women of the Division of Environmental Health at the Department of Public Health and Social Services. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in Fiscal Year 2019, the Division of Environmental Health generated One Million Five Hundred Thousand Two Hundred Four Dollars (\$1,500,204) and expects to generate this same amount with a great possibility of generating more revenue with the adoption of a proposed fee increase for Sanitary Permits. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in Fiscal Year 2019, the Division was appropriated One Million Four Hundred Thousand Three Hundred Six Dollars

1 (\$1,400,306) and even less in Fiscal Year 2020 at One Million Three Hundred Seven
2 Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$1,307,674), less than their request
3 and the ceiling set by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research of One
4 Million Three hundred Ninety-Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars
5 (\$1,396,120). Additionally, the Department of Public Health and Social Service’s
6 Central Administrative building was closed down due to an electrical fire and thus
7 additional support, fiscal and physical, are necessary for the Division to carry out
8 their mandates.

9 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend Part II of Chapter
10 III of Public Law 35-36, the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget Law, to increase the
11 appropriation to the Division of Environmental Health of the Department of Public
12 Health and Social Services from the Environmental Health Fund to provide
13 additional support for effective and efficient execution of their mandates and
14 programs in line with the prescribed use of the Fund and to add a new Section 18 to
15 authorize the Department to use all of the funds generated in the Special Funds that
16 are available to them for the Fiscal Year.

17 **Section 2.** Part II of Chapter III of Public Law 35-36 is hereby *amended* to
18 read:

21 **PART II – DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES**

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** The sum of Fifty-six Million ~~Three~~ Five
23 ~~Hundred Eighty-seven~~ Seventy-nine Thousand ~~Two~~ Five Hundred ~~Twelve~~ Thirty-
24 eight Dollars (~~\$56,387,212~~\$56,579,538) is appropriated to the Department of Public
25 Health and Social Services (DPHSS) for its operations for Fiscal Year 2020. This
26 sum is composed of Forty-one Million Seven Hundred Seven Thousand Seven
27 Hundred Forty-three Dollars (\$41,707,743) from the General Fund, and Fourteen

1 Million ~~Six~~ Eight Hundred Seventy-~~nine~~one Thousand ~~Four~~ Seven Hundred Sixty-
 2 ~~nine~~ Ninety-five Dollars (~~\$14,679,469~~14,871,795) from the Healthy Futures Fund,
 3 the Environmental Health Fund, the Health Professional Licensing Office Revolving
 4 Fund, the Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund, and the Sanitary Inspection
 5 Revolving Fund.

6 The sum of *up to* Forty-seven Million Six Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand
 7 Two Hundred Ninety-six Dollars (\$47,638,296) appropriated from the General Fund
 8 and the Healthy Futures Fund in this Section is authorized as the local matching
 9 requirement for Federal Grants-in-Aid.

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21 **Section 2.** A new Section 18 is *added* to Part II of Chapter III in Public Law
 22 35-36 to read:

23 **“Section 18. Funding Source.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
 24 the Department of Public Health and Social Services is authorized to expend up to
 25 the level of revenues collected for Fiscal Year 2020 and unexpended carryover in
 26 revolving funds only for the purposes authorized by statute for the fund: Guam

1 Environmental Health Fund; Health Professional Licensing Office Revolving Fund;
2 Office of Vital Statistics Revolving Fund; and Sanitary Inspection Revolving Fund.”

3 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

4 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
5 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions
6 or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or
7 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
