BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1.	Duties and Obligations of a Parent to a Child. A new Article 5 is hereby add	ed
to Chapter 4, Title	19 of the Guam Code Annotated, is hereby amended, to read:

§ 4501. Criminal Liability for Failure of a Parent or Legal Guardian to Exercise Reasonable Care, Supervision, Protection, and Control Over Their Minor Child.

(a) A parent or legal guardian to any person under the eighteen (18) years of age shall have the duty to exercise reasonable care, supervision, protection, and control over their minor child.

(b) It shall be a violation for a parent or legal guardian to by act or omission contrary to their duties under subsection (a) of this section permit or encourage their minor child to commit any felony or misdemeanor crime. A violation of the provisions of this subjection shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or a term of imprisonment of up to one (1) year) or both."

Section 2. Compiler of Laws. The Compiler of Laws shall recodify 18 GCA §90113 (Parental Liability for Willful Acts of Minor Children) as a new §4502 of Article 5, Chapter 4, Title 19 of the Guam Code Annotated.
