**AN ACT TO AMEND § 61541(f)(3) OF SUBARTICLE 5,

TUMON BAY H RESORT-HOTEL ZONE AND DIGITAL  
SIGNAGE REGULATIONS.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** § 61541(f)(3) of Subarticle 5, Article 5, Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

“(3) Violations. (a) Any person in violation of Subsections 61541(f)-(f)(2) and any provision of § 61547 of Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, shall pay a civil penalty ~~not to exceed~~ of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for each violation. If violation(s) are not ~~corrected~~ rectified within ten (10) business days of receipt of a Notice of Violation from the Department of Public Works, such person shall be subject to ~~an additional~~ late action civil penalty ~~not to exceed~~ of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) per day for each remaining violation. Failure to pay penalties and to rectify the violations may result in the termination or non-renewal of the digital sign permit. The Director of Public Works shall have the authority to waive parts or all of the late action penalty should the violator demonstrate a good faith effort to address the violation in a timely manner; provided, that such waiver

1 is limited to *no more than* thirty (30) calendar days. All penalties recovered in any  
2 such action *shall* be paid into the General Public Signage Enforcement Fund.

3 Any person or business, within ten (10) working days of receipt of a Notice  
4 of Violation, may file an appeal of the finding(s) of a violation. The Guam Land  
5 Use Commission shall hear and decide appeals relative to any penalty imposed  
6 pursuant to this Section. The payment of any penalty shall be stayed during  
7 appeals.

8 (b) There is created the “Public Signage Enforcement Fund (Fund).” The  
9 Fund shall not be commingled with any other fund of the Government of Guam or  
10 instrumentality of the Government of Guam. Expenditures from the Fund are  
11 subject to appropriation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and shall be used solely for the  
12 enforcement of this subarticle.”

13 **Section 2. Rules and Regulations Required.** The Guam Land Use  
14 Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations in compliance with the  
15 Administrative Adjudication Law, 5 GCA Chapter 9, to implement the appeals  
16 process provided for in Section 1 of this Act within ninety (90) days of the  
17 enactment of this Act.
