**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$550,000) FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO THE GUAM ELECTION COMMISSION FOR OPERATIONS AND TO CONDUCT THE 2020 PRIMARY ELECTION.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the appropriation for the Guam Election Commission in Fiscal Year 2020 was One Million Three Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Four Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$1,399,414) versus the Commission's request of One Million Nine Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Five Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$1,995,511) and thus inadequate to ensure their operational obligations and election mandates are met.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate from the Fiscal Year 2019 Unappropriated General Fund balance to the Guam Election Commission to ensure the success of the 2020 Primary Election and operational costs of the Commission.

**Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Election Commission.** Up to the sum of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000) is appropriated from the Fiscal Year 2019 Unappropriated General Fund balance to the Guam Election Commission for the purposes of covering operational costs and to conduct the 2020

1 Primary Election. The appropriation in this Section *shall not* lapse and *shall*  
2 continue until fully expended.

3 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

4 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
5 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions  
6 or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or  
7 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
