AN ACT TO APPRORPIATE FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$550,000) FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO THE GUAM ELECTION COMMISSION FOR OPERATIONS AND TO CONDUCT THE 2020 PRIMARY ELECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the appropriation for the Guam Election Commission in Fiscal Year 2020 was One Million Three Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Four Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$1,399,414) versus the Commission's request of One Million Nine Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Five Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$1,995,511) and thus inadequate to ensure their operational obligations and election mandates are met.

8 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate from the 9 Fiscal Year 2019 Unappropriated General Fund balance to the Guam Election 10 Commission to ensure the success of the 2020 Primary Election and operational 11 costs of the Commission.

12 Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Election Commission. Up to the 13 sum of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000) is appropriated from the 14 Fiscal Year 2019 Unappropriated General Fund balance to the Guam Election 15 Commission for the purposes of covering operational costs and to conduct the 2020 Primary Election. The appropriation in this Section *shall not* lapse and *shall* continue until fully expended.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

Section 4. Severablility. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
