AN ACT TO AMEND § 19404 OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 19, TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ENFORCEMENT OF RULES PROMULGATED IN AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RELATIVE TO A DECLARED EMERGENCY TO PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §19404 of Article 4, Chapter 19, Title 10 Guam Code Annotated is
 amended to read:
- 4 "§ 19404. Enforcement.
- 5 (a) During a state of public health emergency, the public health authority may
 6 request assistance in enforcing orders pursuant to this Chapter from the public safety
 7 authority. The public safety authority may request assistance from the organized
 8 militia in enforcing the orders of the public health authority.
- (b) Any person found to be in violation of an Executive Order promulgated
 by I Maga 'hågan Guåhan during a declared emergency to health or safety in the
 exercise of authority under this Chapter or 10 GCA Chapter 65, shall be guilty of a

1	misdemeanor. Upon conviction, the person shall be fined not more than \$5,000, or
2	imprisoned not more than one year, or both."
3	Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
4	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
5	not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
6	without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this
7	Act are severable.
8	Section 3. Effective Date. This act shall be effective upon enactment.
