AN ACT TO AMEND § 715(1)(13) OF CHAPTER 7, TITLE **GUAM** CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CREATING AN EXEMPTION DURING SCHOOL YEAR 2019-2020 **FROM** THE **NINE** HUNDRED (900)REQUIREMENT INSTRUCTIONAL **HOURS FOR** SCHOOLS AS MANDATED **GUAM'S PUBLIC** BY PUBLIC LAW 35-77.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds that Public
- 3 Law 35-77 amended § 715(l)(13) of Chapter 7, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, to
- 4 require nine hundred (900) instructional hours per school year for both elementary
- 5 and secondary schools.
- 6 I Liheslatura recognizes that due to the closure of Guam's public schools due
- 7 to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Guam Department of Education may be unable to
- 8 provide the nine hundred (900) instructional hours as required by Public Law 35-77.

- Thus, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to create an exemption from the nine
- 2 hundred (900) instructional hours requirement for School Year 2019-2020.
- 3 Section 2. § 715(l)(13) of Chapter 7, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is
- 4 hereby *amended* to read the following:
- 5 "(13) at least one hundred eighty (180) instructional days, or its equivalence,
- 6 including make-up hours each school year with school years ending no later than
- 7 thirty (30) days following the end of the calendared school year. The Guam
- 8 Department of Education is hereby exempt from the requirements of § 715(1)(13) of
- 9 Chapter 7, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, for School Year 2019-2020."
- 10 **Section 3.** Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to
- any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
- shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
- without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 14 Act are severable.
- 15 Section 4. Effective Date. Provisions in this Act shall take effect
- 16 immediately upon enactment.
