**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §19501.1 TO CHAPTER 19,
TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO
PROHIBITING THE SEIZURE BY GOVERNMENT
OFFICIALS OF PATIENT'S MAIL-ORDER
PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS, EQUIPMENT,
SUPPLIES AND APPLIANCES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 **Section 1.** A new § 19505.1 is *added* to Chapter 19, Title 10, Guam Code
4 Annotated to read as follows:

6 **§ 19505.1. Proscription of Seizure of Patient's Lawfully Prescribed Drugs,**
7 **Medical supplies and Appliances.**

8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is unlawful for any official of the
9 Government of Guam to seize, confiscate or order to seize or confiscate any
10 resident's lawfully prescribed drugs, pharmaceutical agents including but not
11 limited to chloroquine and hydroxychloroquine; medical devices and medical
12 supplies including but not limited to syringes for the administration of medication,
13 Continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) machines and home dialysis supplies
14 that are imported to Guam via the United States Postal Service or a private
15 shipping carrier or agent.

16 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is unlawful for any official of
17 the Government of Guam require any resident-recipient to declare any lawfully

1 prescribed drugs, pharmaceutical agents including but not limited to chloroquine
2 and hydroxychloroquine; medical devices and medical supplies including but not
3 limited to syringes for the administration of medication, Continuous positive
4 airway pressure (CPAP) machines and home dialysis supplies that are imported to
5 Guam via the United States Postal Service or a private shipping carrier or agent.
6 (c) Any person who violates a provision of this section, *supra*, is personally and
7 civilly liable for a fine in an amount not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
8 and not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each violation.
