## 1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 Section 1. Authorization for the De-appropriation of the Office of Senator Mary Camacho Torres' Unexpended Funds and Re-appropriation to 3 4 the Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense. The sum of Seventy Five 5 Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) is hereby de-appropriated from the unexpended funds of the Office of Senator Mary Camacho Torres of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and re-6 appropriated to the Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense for the sole 7 8 purpose of purchasing face masks, face shields, and other Personal Protective 9 Equipment (PPE) for customer-focused services provided by government of Guam 10 agencies to include but not be limited to: the Guam Department of Labor for the

operation of the Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) Program, the Guam
 Department of Revenue and Taxation, and the Guam Department of Land
 Management. Procurement of this equipment shall fall under the Governor of
 Guam's emergency procurement powers under Chapter 19, Title 10 Guam Code
 Annotated.

- Funds de-appropriated and re-appropriated pursuant to this Section shall be
  allocated to Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense within thirty (30)
  days of the enactment of this Section. No portion of the appropriations shall be used
  for any purpose other than what is specifically authorized in this Section.
- Section 2. Subsection (a) of § 77810 of Chapter 77 of Title 12 Guam Code
  Annotated is hereby *repealed*.
- 12 "(a) The FY 2016 lapsed funds of the Office of Senator Mary Torres of *I*13 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* in an amount not to exceed Seventy-five Thousand Dollars
  14 (\$75,000) are hereby deappropriated and reappropriated to the Guam Economic
  15 Development Authority (GEDA) to fund the Multi-Purpose Community Stadium
  16 Complex Commission to carry out its powers and responsibilities as authorized in §
  17 77807 of this Article."
- 18 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any 19 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions 20 or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision 21 or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
