AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU TO EXPEND ALL FUNDS AVAILABLE IN THE RAINY DAY FUND FOR THE REMAINING FISCAL YEAR 2020.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 2 **Section 1.** Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that pursuant 3 to 12 Guam Code Annotated §9304, the Guam Visitors Bureau has access to fifty percent of its Rainy Day Funds in the event of a disaster. Access to the remaining 4 5 fifty percent is subject to Legislative approval. In recognition of the devastation wrought on the visitor industry as a result of the world-wide COVID-19 pandemic 6 emergency, I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to allow access to all the funds available 7 8 in the Rainy Day Funds for the remainder of the Fiscal Year 2020. 9 Access to the first fifty percent of the Rainy Day Funds was contingent on 10 approval of a resolution by the Board of Directors of the Guam Visitors Bureau 11 containing: 12 (a) statement of facts that a natural or man-made disaster has occurred on 13 Guam, or certain external economic conditions have been experienced; 14 (b) a recitation of the activities to be undertaken to mitigate the potential harm 15 to Guam's tourism industry; and

1	(c) insufficient funds are available for such activities within the current fisca
2	year's operating budget.

Access to the remaining fifty percent shall also require a detailed plan and recitation of the activities to be undertaken to mitigate the harm to the tourism industry.

## Authorization to Expend Balance of Rainy Day Fund. 6 Section 2. 7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Guam Visitors Bureau is authorized to expend on a continuing basis the balance of the Rainy Day Fund throughout 8 9 FY2020 to mitigate the harm and rebuild the tourism industry in the aftermath of the 10 COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, declared by the Governor of Guam on March 11 16, 2020. To avail of these funds, the Board of Directors of the Guam Visitors 12 Bureau shall submit a Resolution to the Speaker detailing the planned use of the funds prior to expenditure. This authorization shall continue until all funds in the 13

Rainy Day Fund as of September 30, 2020, are expended.
