AN ACT TO AMEND § 22436(a) OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 22, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING AN APPROPRIATION BY I LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND REVENUES.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 22436(a) of Article 4, Chapter 22, Division 2, Title 5, Guam
- 3 Code Annotated, is amended to read:
- 4 "§ 22436. General Fund Appropriations to the Rainy Day Fund Cap.
- 5 (a) Beginning in Fiscal Year 2010, *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) shall not
- 6 appropriate more than ninety-eight percent (98%) of the total revenues projected
- 7 for the General Fund for the fiscal year until such time as the General Fund deficit
- 8 is eliminated. Subject to an appropriation by I Liheslaturan Guåhan, Aall
- 9 unappropriated annual General Fund revenues collected in excess of appropriations
- shall be used to liquidate obligations for refunds, earned income tax credits, and
- 11 prior years' vendor payables.

- 1 I Liheslatura (the Legislature) shall appropriate not less than two percent
- 2 (2%) of the total revenues projected for the General Fund for each fiscal year to the
- 3 Rainy Day Fund established pursuant to § 22901, Article 9, Division 2, Chapter 22,
- 4 Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, until such time as indicated in § 22904, Article 9,
- 5 Division 2, Chapter 22, Title 5 GCA."
- 6 Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
- 7 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
- 8 shall not affect other provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of
- 9 this Act are severable.
- 10 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon
- 11 enactment.
