AN ACT TO AMEND §§ 81109 and 81112 AND ADD A NEW § 81113, ALL OF CHAPTER 81, TITLE 10, GCA, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION ON POST MORTEM EXAMINATIONS TO ESTABLISH FEES AND TO ESTABLISH A POST-MORTEM EXAMINATIONS FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.
- 3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that in January 2019, the Commission on Post
- 4 Mortem Examination through its Chairperson, the Attorney General of Guam,
- 5 requested that legislation be introduced to establish a special fund for the Office of
- 6 Post-Mortem Examinations (OCME) and to allow the OCME to charge fees for its
- 7 services.

- 8 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to authorize the Commission on
- 9 Post-Mortem Examinations to establish a fee schedule that the Commission may
- adjust regularly pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act. To the fullest
- extent possible, the Commission shall consider hardship of families and strive to
- ensure that nonpayment of accrued fees does not limit or delay the release of
- human remains to the families for burial. The Commission shall adjust its
- processes to facilitate reimbursement of these fees to victims' families by the
- 15 Victims Compensation Fund when applicable.

1	It is also the intent of <i>I Liheslaturan Guåhan</i> that payment of any fees
2	established by the Commission will be controlled by the OCME and will go
3	towards supporting the operations of the office.
4	Section 2. § 81109 of Chapter 81, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated is
5	amended to read:
6	"§ 81109. Rules and Regulations. Subject to the Administrative
7	Adjudication Act, the Commission may promulgate fees, rules and regulations
8	necessary or appropriate to carry out effectively the provision of this Chapter."
9	Section 3. § 81112 of Chapter 81, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated is
10	amended to read:
11	"§ 81112. Severability. Post-Mortem Examinations Fund.
12	(a) If any provision or application of this Chapter is held invalid, such
13	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of the Chapter
14	which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and
15	to this end, the provisions of this Chapter are declared to be severable. There
16	is hereby established a fund to be known as the Post-Mortem Examinations
17	Fund ("Fund") which shall be maintained separate and apart from other
18	funds of the Government of Guam and independent records and accounts
19	shall be maintained in connection therewith. All fees collected by the Office
20	of Post-Mortem Examinations, otherwise referred to as the Office of the
21	Chief Medical Examiner ("OCME"), under this Chapter shall be deposited
22	into the Fund.
23	(b) The Fund shall be used exclusively for the purpose of the
24	administration of the OCME. The Fund shall be examined and reported by
25	the OCME.
26	(c) Transfers and expenditures from the Fund shall not occur without
27	approval of the Commission on Post-Mortem Examinations."

- Section 4. A new § 81113 is *added* to Chapter 81, Title 10, Guam Code
- 2 Annotated to read:
- 3 "§ 81113. Severability. If any provision or application of this Chapter is
- 4 held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of the
- 5 Chapter which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application,
- 6 and to this end, the provisions of this Chapter are declared to be severable."
