1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
2	Section 1. A new § 57108 is hereby added to Chapter 57, Title 10 Guam
3	Code Annotated to read:
4	"§ 57108. Guam Identification Card for Residents Age 65 or Older.
5	Any resident of Guam aged sixty-five (65) years or older may apply for a
6	Guam Identification Card, which shall not expire. The card shall not be an
7	identification card compliant with the Real ID Act of 2005 (U.S. Public Law 109-
8	13, 119 Stat. 302) or any of its succeeding statutes. All fees and documentation as
9	required by the Guam Department of Revenue and Taxation for a non-REAL ID
10	Guam Identification Card shall apply. The notation "Non-Expiring" shall be placed
11	on the card."
12	Section 2. This Act shall go into effect thirty (30) days from the date of
13	enactment.
14	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
15	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
16	not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
