AN ACT TO *APPROPRIATE* TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE GUAM SALVATION ARMY LIGHTHOUSE RECOVERY CENTER, *APPROPRIATE* TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE OASIS EMPOWERMENT CENTER, AND *APPROPRIATE* FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE GUAM BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER DRUG AND ALCOHOL NEW BEGINNINGS FROM THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.**

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that there is a need for more drug and alcohol
4 rehabilitation services on Guam. Although services do exist, it is urgent that we build
5 capacity to expand availability of treatment and care. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds
6 that additional funding is needed so that more individuals who seek residential care
7 may have ready access.

8 It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate funds from
9 the Healthy Futures Funds to the Salvation Army Lighthouse Recovery, Oasis
10 Empowerment Center, and the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center Drug

1 and Alcohol New Beginnings for certain purposes, as described. This Act is to
2 become effective on October 1, 2020.

3 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Salvation Army Lighthouse Recovery**
4 **Center.** The sum of Two Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$275,000)
5 is appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund to the Salvation Army Lighthouse
6 Recovery Center for the purposes of funding residential treatment programs,
7 outpatient services, and to increase bed capacity. The appropriation in this Section
8 shall not lapse and shall continue until fully expended.

9 **Section 3. Appropriation to the Oasis Empowerment Center.** The sum of
10 Two Hundred and Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$275,000) is appropriated from the
11 Healthy Futures Fund to the Oasis Empowerment Center for the purposes of funding
12 residential treatment programs, outpatient services, and to increase bed capacity. The
13 appropriation in this Section shall not lapse and shall continue until fully expended.

14 **Section 4. Appropriation to the New Beginnings Drug and Alcohol**
15 **Treatment.** The sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the
16 Healthy Futures Fund for the purposes of funding the prevention and training branch.
17 The appropriation in this Section shall not lapse and shall continue until fully
18 expended.

19 **Section 5.** This Act shall become effective on October 1, 2020.
