AN ACT TO ADD § 15212 TO CHAPTER 15, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING CONTRACTS OR POST EMPLOYMENT FOR FORMER ELECTED OFFICIALS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 15212 is hereby *added* to Chapter 15, Title 4, Guam Code
- 3 Annotated to read as follows:
- 4 § 15212. Contracts or Post Employment for Former Elected Officials.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other provisions of the law, rule, or regulation to the
- 6 contrary, no former elected official shall accept any employment as a classified,
- 7 <u>unclassified, appointed, temporary, limited term appointment, exempted employee,</u>
- 8 or enter into a contractual arrangement for service in the government of Guam or
- 9 any government of Guam instrumentality within twelve (12) months from their last
- 10 day in the elected position. The only exception to this provision shall be if the
- position is as an educator with the Guam Department of Education, University of
- 12 Guam, or the Guam Community College; as a licensed health professional at the
- 13 Guam Memorial Hospital or Department of Public Health and Social Services; as a
- duly sworn peace officer of the law; or in a position as an elected official.
- 15 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
- person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*

- 1 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
- 2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 3 severable.
- 4 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective immediately upon
- 5 enactment.
