**AN ACT TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS NECESSARY  
TO SAFEGUARD THE PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE  
PEOPLE OF GUAM BY AMENDING PUBLIC LAW NO.  
35-99.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Section 3, Part II, Chapter III, of P.L. 35-99 is *amended* as  
follows:**

**“ Section 3. Medicaid Program.**

**(a)** The sum of Six Million Six Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Three Hundred  
Seventy-three Dollars (**\$6,662,373**) from the General Fund and Six Million  
Five Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-four Dollars  
**(\$6,521,824)** from the Healthy Futures Funds shall be allocated and  
authorized from the appropriations in Section 1 of this Part of this Chapter  
as the local matching requirement for the Medicaid Program. The sum of  
Fifty-five Million Eight Hundred Fifty-six Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-  
nine Dollars (**\$55,856,539**) is authorized from Federal Matching Grants-  
in-Aid to DPHSS for said purpose for Fiscal Year 2021. The funds  
allocated and authorized in this Section are not subject to I Maga'hågan  
Guåhan's transfer authority.

1           (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of no more than Two  
2           Million Seven Hundred Seventy Two Thousand Four Hundred Nine  
3           Dollars (\$2,772,409) is hereby appropriated from the fund balance of the  
4           Healthy Futures Fund as reflected in the Fiscal Year 2019 Government of  
5           Guam Basic Financial Statements, Additional Information and  
6           Independent Auditors' Report, to the Department of Public Health and  
7           Social Services as the local matching requirement for the Medicaid  
8           Program and shall be available until fully expended for the original  
9           purposes of said appropriation.

10           **Section 2. Section 9, Part II, Chapter III of P.L. 35-99 is hereby**  
11 ***amended* as follows:**

12           **“Section 9. DPHSS Continuing Appropriation Authorization for MIP**  
13 **and Medicaid.** The unexpended balance of appropriations from the General Fund  
14 and ~~Special Funds~~ Healthy Futures Fund to DPHSS for MIP and Medicaid in Fiscal  
15 Year 2020 and Fiscal Year 2021 shall not revert to the General Fund or the Healthy  
16 Futures Fund and shall be available until fully expended for the original purposes of  
17 said appropriations. The Director of DPHSS shall submit a report to the Speaker of  
18 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* regarding the allocation, demographics, and expenditures of  
19 the appropriations contained herein no later than thirty (30) days after the end of  
20 each quarter and post the same on the DPHSS website. The Director of  
21 Administration shall pay MIP and Medicaid vendors on a first-in, first-out basis.

22           **Section 3. Section 21, Part II, of Chapter III is hereby *added* to P.L. 35-**  
23 **99 as follows:**

24           **“Section 21. Department of Public Health and Social Services**  
25 **Supplemental Operations.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum  
26 of no more than Eight Million Seven Hundred Forty-five Thousand Six Hundred  
27 Eighty-one Dollars (\$8,745,681) for its operations is hereby appropriated from the

1 fund balance of the Healthy Futures Fund as reflected in the Fiscal Year 2019  
2 Government of Guam Basic Financial Statements, Additional Information and  
3 Independent Auditors' Report, to the Department of Public Health and Social  
4 Services for FY 2021 and shall be available until fully expended.”

5       **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon the date of  
6 enactment.

7       **Section 5. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
8 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall  
9 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without  
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
11 severable.
