AN ACT TO GRANT ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION OF A TWO (2) ACRE SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (6,120) SQUARE METER PORTION OF PARCEL 5109-R2 LOT 5109-REM, MUNICIPALITY OF TAMUNING TO THE GUAM REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

#### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Findings and Intent. I Liheslatura finds that this legislation is 2 required to expend over a two hundred thousand in federal funds that are already in 3 hand to design and build a mass transit facility to improve services to the people of 4 Guam. 5 6 Section 2. Grant of Administrative Jurisdiction of a Two (2) Acre 7 Portion of Parcel 5109 R2 Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty (6,120) Square Meter Lot 5109-REM, Municipality of Tamuning to the Guam Regional 8 9 Transit Authority.
- 10 (a) Administrative Jurisdiction of a Two (2) Acre Portion of Parcel
  11 5109-R2 Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty (6,120) Square Meter Lot
  12 5109-REM, Municipality of Tamuning as shown on Map 055FY2014

<u>393FY2018</u> is hereby granted to the Guam Regional Transit Authority for the purpose of developing and constructing a *maintenance and office* facility for the use of the Guam Regional Transit Authority and the People of Guam.

- (b) If the property is not developed into a functioning *maintenance* facility and office within Three (3) years, administrative jurisdiction of the Guam Regional Transit Authority shall expire, and the property shall revert back to the inventory of the Chamorro Land Trust Government of Guam.
- (c) A survey map designating the <u>Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty (6,120)</u> Square Meter Lot 5109-REM has already been prepared, recorded, and provided by the Department of Land Management to the Guam Regional Transit Authority. The location of the <del>2-acre portion in Parcel 5109-R2</del> <u>Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty (6,120)</u> Square Meter <u>Lot 5109-REM</u> shall be at the discretion of the Guam Regional Transit Authority.
- Section 3. Exemption from Appraisals. 2 GCA § 2107(b) relative to land appraisals, do not apply to this Act.
  - **Section 4. Severability.** If any of provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, that invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law, which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.
