1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 12130 is added to Article 1, Chapter 12, Division 1,

Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

"§ 12130. Independent Economic Impact Statement on Fiber-Optic Undersea Cable Landing Stations.

On or before June 1, 2019, the Public Utilities Commission shall issue a Request for Proposal for the purpose of conducting an Independent Economic Impact Statement relative to the potential taxation of fiber-optic undersea cable landing stations which use Guam as a pass-through site. The Public Utilities Commission, in collaboration with the Guam Economic Development Authority, shall identify the resources necessary to fund the

Independent Economic Impact Statement. The Public Utilities Commission, in collaboration with the Department of Revenue and Taxation, Guam Economic Development Authority, and the Office of Technology, shall determine the study parameters.

The Independent Economic Impact Statement shall be completed by an identified group that includes an Economist with a Master's Degree or Ph.D. in Economics from an institution of higher learning accredited by an accreditation agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education, or similar accredited body that is recognized internationally, no later than January 1, 2020, and shall be transmitted to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and to *I Maga'håga Guåhan* on or before February 1, 2020."

Section 2. Severability. *If* any provision of this Act or the application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
