THE INDEPENDENT CANDIDATE ELECTION REFORM ACT OF 2019: AN ACT TO ADD §6111 TO CHAPTER 7, TITLE 3 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED AND AMEND §7105 OF CHAPTER 7, TITLE 3, GUAM AN RELATIVE TO **ESTABLISHING** CODE ANNOTATED, INDEPENDENT DESIGNATION FOR I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. A new § 6111 is added to Chapter 6, Title 3, of the Guam 2 Code Annotated, to read: 3
- § 6111. Independent Designation for Candidates for I Liheslaturan Guåhan. 5

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, candidates for I Liheslaturan Guahan, who do not wish to seek the nomination of a political party, may file their declaration of candidacy under the Independent designation. Independent candidates shall file their nominating petition with the Guam Election Commission no earlier than one hundred thirty (130) days before the primary election and no later than sixty (60) days before the primary election. The Guam Election Commission shall not ratify more than fifteen (15) nominating petition papers and all other required documents for candidacy for

1 .	candidates under the independent designation, and no more than fifteen (15)							
2	independent candidates for I Liheslaturan Guåhan shall have a place on the							
3	general or special election ballot in which their name is identified under the							
4	independent designation. The Guam Election Commission shall officially							
5 ¹ ,	record and process independent candidates in the chronological order of receipt							
6	of completed filings."							
7	Section 2. § 7105 of Chapter 7, Title 3, of the Guam Code							
8	Annotated is amended to read:							
9	"§ 7105. Order of Names on Ballot-Liheslatura.							
.0	(a) The Commission shall prepare the ballot in such a							
1	manner that a nominee's name appears under the designation of independent or							
2	name of the political party, if any, sponsoring such nominee.							
3	(b) Each candidate for any office under a party or							
4	independent designation shall be listed according to lots drawn and conducted							
5	by the Election Commission. All drawings for ballot position shall be done							
6	publicly, and person appearing on the ballot shall be specifically invited to							
7	attend. The drawings for ballot placement shall be conducted after the deadline							
8	to file candidacy and the identities of the persons to appear on the ballot is							
9	known to the Election Commission.							
0	(c) The names of the nominees shall appear in columns							
1	vertically in such order as determined by the lots drawn. Those nominees							
2	already holding the office for which they are seeking re-election shall have the							
3	word "Incumbent" printed after their names."							
4	Section 3. Severability.							

If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is

- found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other
- provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of the law are
- severable.

Section 4. Effective Date

This shall be effective upon enactment.
