AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF PART II, CHAPTER **PUBLIC** LAW 35-36, RELATIVE TO OF XIII. REQUIREMENTS **NON-PROFIT** FOR REPORTING GOVERNMENT FUNDED BY **ORGANIZATIONS APPROPRIATIONS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6 of Part II, Chapter XIII, of Public Law 35-36 is hereby
amended:

"Section 6. Reporting Requirements for Non-Profit Organizations. All 4 non-profit organizations that receive funds pursuant to this Act shall maintain 5 financial records that accurately account for said funds and *shall* provide a budgetary 6 breakdown by object category to the department or agency that oversees the 7 appropriation. The non-profit organization *shall* be provided a copy of this Section 8 by the department or agency overseeing such appropriation, but failure of the 9 10 department or agency to fulfill this duty *shall not* prevent any non-profit organization 11 from carrying out its responsibilities under this Section. The non-profit organization 12 *shall* also provide to said department or agency:

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- (a) a quarterly report describing its activities during the reporting period and the results it achieved *no later than* twenty (20) days after the end of each quarter;
- 16 (b) notice of all procurement of equipment and services of Twenty17 five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) or more prior to awarding any such
 18 contract;

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1 access by the overseeing department's or agency's duly (c)2 authorized representative and government of Guam auditors to 3 appropriate records for the purpose of audit and examination of 4 books, documents, papers, and records of funds expended under the 5 appropriation; a detailed inventory listing of each year's purchases, as certified 6 (d)7 by its certifying officer; and a final report containing a full disclosure of all expenditures of 8 (e) 9 funds appropriated by this Act no later than November 15, 2020; 10 the overseeing department or agency shall submit said report to I 11 Liheslaturan Guåhan and shall post the same on its website-; and (f) all advertisements of non-profit organization or sub-grantee 12 programs funded by government funds shall indicate the source of 13 14 funding. Non-compliance with these reporting requirements shall subject the non-15 profit organization to a minimum three percent (3%) reduction or termination of its 16 17 appropriation and shall be referred to the Attorney General's office for investigation; the overseeing department's or agency's contract with the organization shall so 18 provide. Non-compliance with the reporting requirements shall be reported by the 19 agency to the Speaker and the Governor within 5 days of violation and the agency 20 may suspend the non-profit organization from applying for the next grant cycle." 21 Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any 22 Section 2. person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall* 23 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without 24
