AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$11 MILLION DOLLARS TO THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR URGENT REPAIRS, EQUIPMENT, AND INFRASTRUCTURE CRITICAL TO THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO GUAM PENDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HOSPITAL FACILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Pending the planning and construction of a new hospital, it is the 2 intention of *I Liheslatura* to prioritize the safety and quality of care of the residents 3 and visitors to Guam, by investing in the continued accreditation of the Guam 4 Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid 5 Services (CMS) and addressing the most urgent structural deficiencies, equipment 6 needs, and infrastructure deficiencies of the current hospital facility. The priority 7 8 needs of GMHA were assessed by GMHA, CMS and the Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE). Approximately \$21 Million Dollars of priority projects are estimated in 9 order to protect CMS Accreditation and to maintain patient safety pending 10 construction of a new hospital. During FY2020, \$10 Million was appropriated to 11 GMHA from FY2019 Business Privilege Tax revenues in excess of FY2019 12 appropriated revenues through Public Law 35-36 and Bill 210-35 (COR). 13 14 Notwithstanding all other financial demands of the government of Guam, it is the

1 intent of I Liheslatura to prioritize FY 2021 taxpayer dollars towards immediate

health and safety concerns at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority by

immediately dedicating an additional \$11 M to GMHA capital improvement and

equipment priorities. This investment will allow for the adequate planning and

5 thorough vetting of additional long term construction plans for the hospital.

The amount of \$11 Million Dollars is appropriated from Fiscal 6 Section 2. Year 2021 General Fund revenues to the Guam Memorial Hospital Capital 7 Improvement Fund established by Public Law 35-36:ChIII:PartI:5. Notwithstanding 8 any other law, expenditure of these funds shall be subject to approval by the Guam 9 Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees and used strictly for the purpose of 10 continued accreditation of the hospital by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid 11 Services (CMS) and addressing the most urgent priority structural and equipment 12 deficiencies of the current hospital facility. Appropriation into or out of the Guam 13 Memorial Hospital Capital Improvement Fund shall not be subject to the Governor's 14 transfer authority. 15

Section 3. All efforts shall be made by GEDA, GMHA, BSP, other agencies of the Executive Branch, the Governor's Office, *I Liheslatura*, and the *Espetåt-ta*. *Lina'lå-ta*. – Our Hospital. Our Life. Planning Task Force (Task Force) to explore and identify any and all potential government revenue streams, financing sources, or grants, including but not limited to federal government assistance or private financial lending sources that can be utilized for the prompt construction of a new hospital or the priority capital improvement projects of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority facility.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without

- 1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 2 severable.
