AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (f) AND ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (g) OF § 2101.1, AND TO AMEND § 2101.3 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE RECEIPT OF FEDERAL FUNDS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
hereby extends the recognition of judicial independence to the application, receipt
and administration of Federal funds.

Section 2. Subsection (f) is *amended* and a new Subsection (g) is *added* to
 § 2101.1 of Chapter 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

3 "(f) With the exception of the Judiciary of Guam, the Guam Community College, the University of Guam, and the Guam Department of 4 Education, and notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 5 6 no application for any Federal aid programs, grants, loans, contracts, 7 contributions, advances, direct Federal development, or other Federal 8 funding shall be submitted or deemed approved on behalf of the government 9 of Guam or any agency, division, office, department or instrumentality 10 thereof, or any public corporation, without the final approval of the Director 11 of the Guam State Clearinghouse.

12 (g)The Judiciary of Guam, the Guam Community College, the 13 University of Guam, and the Guam Department of Education *shall* provide a 14 courtesy electronic or written copy of each grant application to the Guam 15 State Clearinghouse and I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Copies of all communications between the Federal government grantor agency relative to 16 17 the grant application process with the Judiciary of Guam, the Guam 18 Community College, the University of Guam, or the Guam Department of 19 Education, including all subsequent communications regarding the 20implementation and execution of the grant award, shall also be provided to 21 the Guam State Clearinghouse and I Liheslaturan Guåhan."

Section 3. § 2101.3 of Chapter 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is
hereby *amended* to read:

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"§ 2101.3. Judiciary of Guam, UOG, GCC and DOE Exemptions.

26The Judiciary of Guam, the University of Guam, the Guam27Community College, and the Guam Department of Education *shall* be

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exempted from the provisions prescribed in Title 5 GCA §§ 2101, 2101.1
and 2101.2. However, the Administrator of the Courts, the Presidents of the
University of Guam and the Guam Community College, and the
Superintendent of the Guam Department of Education *shall* separately
perform the following duties and responsibilities:

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(a) administer the initiation, coordination and review process of all activities within the institution involving Federal financial assistance;

9 (b) ensure that grant proposals for Federal assistance are in 10 accordance with plans, policies, programs, objectives and procedures 11 of the government of Guam;

(c) ensure that proposed projects for which Federal financial
assistance is sought are fiscally and environmentally sound and are in
compliance with all applicable Federal laws;

15(d) ensure that the institution complies with all applicable16Federal laws relating to Federal financial assistance, and that there17exists sound tracking, management, and financial accountability for18all Federal programs awarded to the institution;

19 perform a cost analysis on all Federal aid programs, (e) 20 grants, loans, contracts, contributions, advances, direct Federal development, or other Federal funding that the institution is applying 21 22 for, for the financial impact on the institution and the government of 23 Guam's General Fund or special funds used to fund the local 24 matching requirement as prescribed by Federal law; and the financial 25 impact on the institution and the government of Guam for the continuation of the Federal program should the Federal funding expire 26

and require the government of Guam to financially assume the program's operation one hundred percent (100%);

(f) provide a courtesy electronic or written copy of each grant application to the Guam State Clearinghouse and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, including all communications between the Federal government grantor agency relative to the grant application process and the subsequent implementation and execution of the grant award; and

(g) the Administrator of the Courts, the Presidents of the University of Guam and the Guam Community College, and the Superintendent of the Guam Department of Education may delegate any of the foregoing duties and responsibilities to any officers or employees of their respective institution."

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon enactment.
