AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 75125 TO CHAPTER 75 OF TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO DESIGNATING A PORTION OF LOT 5133-1-2, MUNICIPALITY OF TAMUNING, CONSISTING OF 1,024± SQUARE METERS, AS A BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION EASEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AN AREA FOR THE PROMOTION OF BIODIVERSITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that the 19th Guam Legislature recognized the need for a Guam zoological, botanical
- 4 and marine garden through the passage and enactment of Section 14 of Public Law

- 1 19-34 in 1988. Recognizing that a portion of Lot 5133-1-2, municipality of
- 2 Tamuning, consisting of 1,024± square meters, as shown on L.M. Checked No.
- 3 258FY89, was uniquely zoned for this purpose, I Maga'låhen Guåhan, subject to the
- 4 terms and conditions of Public Law 19-34, entered into a twenty (20) year lease with
- 5 Mr. James W. Cushing, who founded the "Guam Zoological, Botanical, and Marine
- 6 Garden" (Cushing Zoo).
- In the Cushing Zoo's nearly twenty (20) years of operation, they have
- 8 successfully bred the Marianas fruit bat, protected nearly twenty-seven (27) separate
- 9 flora and fauna, and exhibited eighteen (18) other species that brought awareness
- and appreciation of animals of all kinds to the public. The Cushing Zoo has become
- an invaluable tool for conservation efforts, housing the many indigenous species of
- 12 flora and fauna of the island and sheltering many more endangered species. The
- 13 Cushing Zoo has performed an invaluable service to the people of Guam and Guam's
- 14 natural biodiversity.
- 15 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to allow the Cushing Zoo
- 16 to remain in operation on a portion of Lot 5133-1-2, municipality of *Tamuning*,
- 17 consisting of 1,024± square meters, as shown on L.M. Checked No. 258FY89;
- 18 provided, that they continue conservation practices of endemic species of flora and
- 19 fauna, they educate the public on conservation efforts, and they continue to bring
- awareness and appreciation of flora and fauna.
- Section 2. A new § 75125 is hereby *added* to Chapter 75 of Title 21, Guam
- 22 Code Annotated, to read:
- 23 "§ 75125. Designation of Biodiversity Conservation Easement.
- 24 (a) Notwithstanding any law, provision, rule, or regulation, the
- Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) is hereby authorized to designate
- Lot 5133-1-2, municipality of *Tamuning*, consisting of 1,024± square meters,
- as shown on L.M. Checked No. 258FY89, as a Biodiversity Conservation

Easement (Easement) for the purposes of promoting awareness, conservation, and preservation of species survival by providing refuge, sanctuary, and habitat restoration for wildlife.

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- The Chamorro Land Trust Commission is authorized to execute a lease for the Easement with James Walter Cushing and Barbara Benavente Cushing—as joint tenants in common with rights of survivorship—and their successors, as provided in 21 GCA § 75109, (hereinafter Cushings), for thirty (30) years at an annual rental rate of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year; provided, that they continue to support and advocate for greater awareness through biological study and education of animal care; encourage and promote awareness, conservation, and preservation of species survival by providing refuge, sanctuary, and habitat restoration for wildlife; engage in conservation practices of endemic species of flora and fauna; educate the public on conservation efforts; and, promote awareness and appreciation of flora and fauna through live exhibitions. The Cushings may elect to renew the lease for a second term of ten (10) years subject to express legislative concurrence. Upon completion of the second term lease, the Cushing Zoo may elect to renew the lease for one (1) subsequent ten (10) year term, subject to express legislative concurrence.
- (c) The Cushings are additionally authorized to operate a for-profit zoo, botanical garden, or marine display on the property, consistent with other requirements of this Section, and may partner with one (1) or more non-profit organizations in the pursuit of their goals for the Easement. The Cushings must maintain compliance with the United States Department of Agriculture and federal and local environmental laws.

(d) If the Cushings are no longer lessees of this property, the Easement *shall* be declared null and void and the property *shall* be consolidated with Lot 5133-1-R2 (*Matapang* Beach Park).

- (e) The Cushings may partner with a non-profit organization in the operations and management of the Biodiversity Conservation Easement and activities on the premises, but the lease *shall not* be sold, transferred, assigned, or subleased."
- **Section 3.** The Cushings are hereby authorized to install or erect signs–electronic, flashing lights, or otherwise, on Lot 5133-1-2; on Lot 5133-1-R2; on the one hundred (100) feet right of way known as San Vitores Road; and on Route 1 Marine Corps Drive, pursuant to 21 GCA, Chapter 61 (Zoning Law).
- **Section 4.** Exemption. § 2107 of Title 2, Guam Code Annotated and the Standing Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* relative to the appraisals of land *shall not* apply to this Act.
- **Section 5. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity *shall not* affect any other provision or application of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
