



**AN ACT TO AMEND § 60109.1(b)(8) OF CHAPTER 60
OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE
TO TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONCEALED
FIREARMS LICENSES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 60109.1(b)(8) of Chapter 60, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated,
3 is *amended* to read as follows.

4 “(8) demonstrates competence with a firearm by any one (1) of the
5 following:

1 (A) is a certified instructor for the courses in the following
2 Subsections (B), (C), (D), (E) or (F);

3 (B) completion of any National Rifle Association firearms
4 safety or training course;

5 (C) completion of any firearms safety or training course or
6 class available to the general public offered by a law enforcement,
7 junior college, college, or private or public institution or organization
8 or firearms training school, utilizing instructors certified by the
9 National Rifle Association, the Criminal Justice Standards and
10 Training Commission, or the Guam Police Department;

11 (D) completion of any law enforcement firearms safety or
12 training course or class offered for security guards, investigators,
13 special deputies, or any division or subdivision of law enforcement or
14 security enforcement;

15 (E) presents equivalent experience with a firearm as
16 evidenced by United States Armed Forces training record, or DD214
17 with a notation of firearms training and honorable discharge; or

18 (F) completion of any firearms training or safety course or
19 class conducted by a Guam-certified or National Rifle Association
20 certified firearms instructor.

21 A photocopy of a certificate of completion, within the past five (5)
22 years, of any of the courses or classes; or an affidavit from the instructor,
23 school, club, organization, or group that conducted or taught said course or
24 class attesting to the completion of the course or class by the applicant; or a
25 copy of any document which shows completion of the course or class or
26 evidences participation in firearms competition *shall* constitute evidence of
27 qualification under this paragraph. Any person who conducts a course

1 pursuant to subparagraph (B), subparagraph (C) or subparagraph (F), or
2 who, as an instructor, attests to the completion of such courses, must
3 maintain records certifying that he or she observed the student safely handle
4 and discharge the firearm. Internet, online, self-study, or correspondence
5 courses are *not* sufficient to satisfy the training requirements of this
6 Subsection;”
