AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 FUND BALANCE OF THE ATTRACTION FUND TO THE GUAM **VISITORS** BUREAU FOR *GUINAHAN FAMAGU'ON* CORPORATION FOR THE **PRINTING** AND DISTRIBUTION OF CHAMORU LITERATURE FOR SCHOOLCHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that the number of Chamoru speakers continues to decline and is under threat of

1 extinction. The average number of "proficient" *Chamoru* speakers is over the age of

2 fifty-five (55) years old. Furthermore, with the average life expectancy of Guam's

3 Chamoru people at sixty-five (65) to seventy (70) years, it is conceivable that the

4 language will be extinct by the year 2025. Efforts must be made to preserve and

protect the *Chamoru* language and culture by encouraging young children to use the

6 Chamoru language in their daily lives.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that many untold stories and cultural practices remain untold and undocumented. These stories and cultural practices should be preserved and put in a format that is accessible to schoolchildren. An increase in diverse Chamoru literature will allow schoolchildren to expand their vocabulary and enhance their understanding of grammar and syntax in the Chamoru language, while learning about cultural practices. Through the work of Guinahan Famagu'on Corporation, intensive research has been done to discover some of Guam's unique stories and practices to be placed in literature for schoolchildren.

It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide funding for the printing and distribution of *Chamoru* literature for schoolchildren.

Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated, unallocated fund balance of the Fiscal Year 2016 Tourist Attraction Fund to the Guam Visitors Bureau for *Guinahan Famagu'on* Corporation for the printing and distribution of *Chamoru* literature for schoolchildren in the *Chamoru* Language and Culture Program of the Guam Department of Education.

Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions contained herein *shall* be effective upon enactment of this Act.
