AN ACT TO TRANSFER THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND **DOLLARS (\$300,000) FROM THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY** CONTRIBUTION THE GUAM **ECONOMIC** DEVELOPMENT **AUTHORITY (GEDA) RECEIVES** FROM THE GUAM HEALTHCARE DEVELOPMENT, INC., DBA GUAM REGIONAL MEDICAL CITY (GRMC) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR **DEPOSIT IN THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND; AND TO** APPROPRIATE THREE HUNDRED **THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC** HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES DIVISION AND PROGRAM.

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# **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

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Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 13-062, recommending the issuance of a Qualifying Certificate (QC) to Guam Healthcare Development, Inc., dba Guam Regional
 Medical City (GRMC) based upon the findings set forth in Case Analysis Case No.
 12-12-03 presented to the GEDA Board of Directors. Such recommendation
 provided that tax abatements and rebates be approved, to include a corporate income
 tax rebate at seventy-five percent (75%) for twenty (20) years, a corporate tax
 dividend tax rebate at seventy-five percent (75%) for five (5) years, and a real
 property tax abatement at one hundred percent (100%) for ten (10) years.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan also finds that subject to such recommended approval 8 of the QC to GRMC, the Annual Community Contribution to be provided to the 9 government of Guam is as follows: Year 1: Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 10 (\$500,000); Year 2: Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000); Years 3 to 11 5: One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000); Years 6 to 10: One Million Two Hundred 12 Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000); and Years 11 to 20: One Million Four Hundred 13 Thousand Dollars (\$1,400,000). Such funds were recommended to be allocated to 14 health care, public safety, economic development, higher education, and cultural 15 16 preservation.

17 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that for Fiscal Year 2019, the government of Guam expects to receive One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) in Annual Community 18 Contributions from the GRMC; and I Liheslaturan Guåhan contends that such 19 Annual Community Contributions can be, and is, subject to legislative appropriation. 20 Therefore, I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to transfer such funds to the 21 Healthy Futures Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 for the purpose of funding the Child 22 Protective Services Division and Program pursuant to this Act; and it is also the 23 intent of I Liheslaturan Guahan to expand Child Protective Service response to 24 referrals and to expand active field work to ensure homeless children and other 25

children throughout the island are protected from physical abuse, provided adequate
shelter, and are able to avail services for their welfare.

1 Transfer of Funds from the Guam Economic Development Section 2. Authority to the Department of Administration. Notwithstanding any other 2 provision of law, rule, or regulation, the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 3 (\$300,000) of the Annual Community Contribution from the Guam Healthcare 4 Development, Inc., dba Guam Regional Medical City received by the Guam 5 Economic Development Authority, from the effective date of this Act to September 6 30, 2019, shall be transferred from the Guam Economic Development Authority to 7 the Department of Administration within five (5) days of receipt of any portion or 8 portions received thereof. The Department of Administration shall deposit such 9 funds and record the revenue thereof into the Healthy Futures Fund, subject to 10 appropriation by I Liheslaturan Guåhan in the General Appropriations Act of 2019 11 12 and this Act.

Section 3. Appropriation to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for the Child Protective Services Division. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, or regulation, the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) is hereby appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for the sole purpose of hiring additional Child Protective Services social workers, and funding training and supplies, for the Child Protective Services Division and Program.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.
Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
severable.
