AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 26203.2 TO ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 26, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING LIMITED EXEMPTIONS TO SMALL BUSINESSES UNDER "THE DAVE SANTOS SMALL BUSINESS ENHANCEMENT ACT."

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. A new § 26203.2 is hereby added to Article 2, Chapter 26,
- 3 Division 2, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, to read:
- 4 "§ 26203.2. Limited Exemption for Certain Small Businesses.
- 5 The taxes levied under this Article in excess of those generated from
- 6 three percent (3%) of the gross proceeds of business privilege tax referenced
- 7 in § 26202 shall not apply to the first One Hundred Thousand Dollars

(\$100,000) earned or received per taxable year by any person from real property rentals, retailing, service income, commission income, licensed insurance premium, and/or farming, whose gross annual income is in excess of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) but *not more than* Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) during the most recent tax year; provided, however, that such person(s) *shall* be fully subject to three percent (3%) of the gross proceeds of business privilege tax referenced in § 26202, subject to the existing requirements and exemptions referenced elsewhere in this Article. The exemption set forth in this Section *shall* apply annually, commencing on the first day of the month of the new tax year, based on the gross annual income of a person during the most recent year, and *shall* end on the last day of the last month of the same tax year."

Section 2. Reporting Requirements. Beginning on January 1, 2021, the Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall* provide an annual report to *I Maga'hagån Guåhan* and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Such report *shall* be transmitted by January 1 of each year, and *shall* include the cumulative number of W-2 forms filed and the business privilege taxes paid by all businesses using the exemption in 11 GCA § 26203.2, and the number of new business licenses for the year; and such report *shall* further provide comparable data for the prior five (5) years.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act *shall* be effective on January 1, 2020.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
