BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that accreditation is crucial in determining whether an institution meets the standard

1	of quality education. Accredited secondary institutions are especially important for						
2	students to have access to any college in the United States.
