AN ACT TO AMEND § 26603(d)(1) OF ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER 26, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO HEALTHY FUTURES FUND PROCEEDS AUTHORIZED FOR THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY LINE OF CREDIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that Public Law 30-166, which was signed into law on July 16, 2010, inadvertently
- 4 references 10 GCA § 80104(t) with respect to a line of credit authorized for the
- 5 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA). The intent of Public Law 30-166 was

- 1 to utilize the Healthy Futures Fund to create a debt service and bond payment
- 2 funding source by allocating a portion of the Healthy Futures Fund proceeds to
- 3 GMHA.
- 4 Recognizing that 10 GCA § 80104 deals with the policy of GMHA regarding
- 5 prohibition against discrimination, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to
- 6 reference the correct section of 10 GCA Chapter 80, and ensure that GMHA is able
- 7 to seek a line of credit as may be necessary and authorized by law.
- 8 Section 2. § 26603(d)(1) of Article 6, Chapter 26, Title 11, Guam Code
- 9 Annotated, is amended to read:
- "(1) The sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) of the taxes
- 11 collected pursuant to this Section shall be allocated and is appropriated, and
- shall continue to be deemed appropriated annually to the Guam Memorial
- Hospital Authority for the sole and specific purpose of funding for the line of
- credit pursuant to 10 GCA § 80109(s)."
- 15 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
- person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
- 17 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
- 18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
- 19 severable.
