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


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'HÅGAN GUÅHAN



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 49119 OF CHAPTER 49, DIVISION
2, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE
TO THE ULTRA-LOW SULFUR DIESEL FUEL
STANDARD ON GUAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 49119 of Chapter 49, Division 2, Title 10, Guam Code
3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

4 **"§ 49119. Ultra-Low Sulfur Diesel Fuel Standard.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule or administrative
6 policy or waiver, effective January 1, 2011, all diesel fuel imported to Guam

1 *shall* meet the USEPA standards for *ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel*. For purposes
2 of this Section, *ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel shall* be generally defined as fuel
3 that contains fifteen parts per million (15ppm) or less of sulfur content, as
4 established by the USEPA Direct Final Rule. The Guam Environmental
5 Protection Agency Board of Directors *shall* create compliance standards for
6 diesel fuel. Any waivers of the fifteen parts per million (15ppm) sulfur content
7 standard of this Section *shall* require approval by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan.*”

8 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.

9 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
10 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
11 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
13 severable.
