AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE MAYORS COUNCIL OF GUAM FROM THE GUAM HIGHWAY FUND FOR VILLAGE STREETS MAINTENANCE AND BEAUTIFICATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds

that based on the testimony provided by the Director of the Bureau of Budget and

4 Management Research during the Legislative Session on Bill No. 207(LS), the FY

5 2009 projected revenues for the Guam Highway Fund were understated as a result

of the misclassification of revenues for the Highway Fund. The Director further

7 testified that the projection for FY 2009 for this fund was now at \$18,957,811, an

- increase of \$2,571,024 over the Governor's original request of \$16,386,787. I
- 2 Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that as a result of the testimony provided, a
- 3 floor amendment was made to increase the FY 2009 revenue estimate for the
- 4 Guam Highway Fund to \$18,957,811, however, no corresponding appropriation
- 5 had been made, or requested by the Administration, leaving an unappropriated
- 6 revenue balance of \$2,571,024. Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to
- 7 provide additional funding to the Mayors Council of Guam from this fund, for the
- 8 purposes stated herein.
- 9 Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Two Million Seventy-one Thousand Twenty-four Dollars (\$2,071,024) is appropriated
- 11 from the FY 2009 Guam Highway Fund revenues to the Village Streets Fund for
- 12 the Mayors Council of Guam, for the maintenance and beautification of village
- 13 secondary and tertiary roads, including the hiring of personnel specifically for
- 14 village streets maintenance and beautification; and for Mayoral Employees
- 15 Separation Pay. Said funds shall not be subject to any transfer authority of I
- 16 Maga'lahen Guåhan and shall be divided among the Village Mayors as follows:
- 17 (a) Each Mayor *shall* receive the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars
- 18 **(\$20,000)**; and
- 19 (b) The remaining balance of the fund *shall* be distributed to each
- 20 Mayor *pro rata* based on the total road mileage in his village as
- a percentage of Guam's total road mileage in the 2006 Guam
- Roads Pavement Inventory of the Department of Public Works.
- The appropriation made in this section shall be available to the Mayors
- 24 Council of Guam until fully expended, for the purposes contained in this section.
