An Act mandating the reimbursement of \$4,076,640 to the Territorial Education Facilities Fund for the purposes set forth in Public Law 29-52 to avert the shutdown of public schools.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslatura* finds that

3 Public Law 29-52 appropriated \$4,076,640 from debt service savings on the

4 refinancing of the 1993 General Obligations Series A Bond to the

5 Department of Education. The government of Guam later dedicated these

6 revenues for other purposes. The Legislature, through Public Law 29-113,

7 then mandated the reimbursement of \$4,076,640 to the Territorial

8 Education Facilities Fund.

9 Public Law 29-19, which authorized the governor to transfer special

10 funds, also mandates that the funds be reimbursed as cash becomes

1	available. Projected revenues for Fiscal Year 2008 were \$489 million.
2	Actual revenues collected amount to \$513 million, a \$24 million surplus,
3	based on the audited financial statements of Fiscal Year 2008. It is the
4	intent of I Liheslatura to ensure this funding is returned to the Department
5	of Education and prevent the shutdown of public schools.
6	Section 2. Reimbursement to the Department of Education. The
7	amount of \$4,076,640 appropriated in Public Law 29-52 and later used for
8	other purposes shall be reimbursed to the Territorial Education Facilities
9	Fund for the purposes set forth in Public Law 29-52 and shall be
10	immediately released by the Department of Administration to the
11	Department of Education.
12	Section 3. Enactment. This act shall be effective immediately upon
13	its passage.
