AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE TO RECRUIT AND RETAIN AN ATTORNEY-AT-LAW THAT WILL PROVIDE LEGAL ADVICE AND GUIDANCE REGARDING DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES, TO INCLUDE ON-GOING COMPLIANCE WITH THE U.S. DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM PERMANENT INJUNCTION.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Finding. I Liheslaturan Guahan recognizes that the 2 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse provides critical mental and 3 health services to individuals in the community who require such services. I 4 Liheslaturan Guahan further recognizes that the Department has been under a 5 permanent court injunction for approximately five years, as imposed by the U.S. 6 District Court of Guam, which places a tremendous challenge on the Department to 7 provide necessary and timely services to its clients. The Department is in need of a 8 full-time legal counsel to assist in the general compliance of the injunction 9 requirements, and to further advise in other areas dealing with the provision of its 10 client services. 11

I Liheslaturan Guahan also finds it appropriate that in the initial implementation of in-house legal services, the necessary funding required shall originate from the Department's budgetary allocation for the Fiscal Year 2010.

Section 2. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of I Liheslatura Guahan to authorize the Department to directly acquire an in-house attorney who would provide general legal advice and guidance, as well as specific guidance and/or legal representation in addressing the on-going court injunction requirements. The recruitment and retention of the attorney would be funded through the Department's existing budgetary allocation.

**Section 3.** A new §86105.1 is added to Chapter 86, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

"§86105.1 Authorization for Legal Counsel. The Department is authorized to acquire and retain, on a full-time-equivalent basis, an in-house legal counsel for the purpose of generally providing legal advice, representation and guidance on matters pertaining to the provision of the Department's services, and/or legal matters pertaining to or affecting the Department. The Department's legal counsel shall also serve as the legal counsel for the Council on Mental Health and Substance Abuse.

- (a) The hiring of the legal counsel shall be conducted by the Director, who shall take all necessary actions relative to the recruitment, review, approval/disapproval, hiring and/or discharge of the legal counsel.
- (b) The position of legal counsel shall be an unclassified full-timeequivalent position subject to the authority of the Director.

1	(c) Nothing in this §86105.1 shall preclude or prevent the Director
2	from acquiring the legal services of the Office of the Attorney
3	General, as provided pursuant to §30102 of Chapter 30, Division
1	3, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated."

Section 4. Funding Authorization from Current FY-2010 Department Appropriation. For the purposes of funding the implementation of this Act, the Department shall be authorized to utilize funds appropriated pursuant to the Department's Fiscal Year 2010 budget.
