AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE UNRESERVED BALANCE **OF THE TERRITORIAL EDUCATION FACILITIES FUND TO** THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND **SUBSTANCE** ABUSE THE FOR Ι FAMAGU'ON-TA **PROGRAM.** DEPARTMENT OF **EDUCATION** FOR CLASSROOM SUPPLIES, THE MAYORS COUNCIL OF **GUAM FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND UPKEEP OF PUBLIC** SCHOOL GROUNDS, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES TO FILL VACANCIES FOR ADDITIONAL NURSES AND **MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS, AND THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF BASIC SUPPLIES** FOR ITS PATIENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

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Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslatura finds there is \$7,401,972 in the Unreserved Fund Balance of the Territorial Education Facilities Fund, according to the audited FY 2008 Government of Guam Financial Statements.

I Liheslatura finds Guam's evolving system of care for children with severe
emotional disorders and their families is critical and indispensable to the education
of marginalized children and the future of the island. Federal funding for the *I*

Famagu'on-ta program, which was created to pool this system of care and has become the foundation for care for hundreds of struggling families, expires September 30, 2009. *I Liheslatura* provided funding for the operations of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse that considers the operational needs of *I Famagu'on-ta*, however, there is no direct appropriation for the program, which requires additional financial resources.

I Liheslatura further finds public school teachers and students perennially
 are burdened by a lack of classroom supplies to improve learning. Funding for the
 Department of Education is needed to provide these resources so teachers and
 parents are not spending on supplies, which should be provided.

I Liheslatura further finds the mayors and vice mayors of Guam have been mandated to provide for the maintenance and upkeep of the grounds of Guam's public schools. Funding for this mandate has been limited and mayors have requested supplemental funding for this purpose. It is critical the mayors and vice mayors of Guam have the resources to provide safe environments for the island's school children.

I Liheslatura further finds the Department of Public Health and Social
 Services was supposed to receive an additional \$431,635 to fund critical vacancies
 in the Fiscal Year 2010 budget.

I Liheslatura further finds the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority has a
 constant shortage of basic supplies for its patients.

Section 2. Appropriation to *I Famagu'on-ta*. The sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) is hereby appropriated from the Unreserved Fund Balance of the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse for the *I Famagu'on-ta* program. This appropriation is not subject to the Governor's transfer authority or the Bureau of Budget and Management Research's allotment process and shall be used exclusively for the *Famagu'on-ta* program. The Department of Administration shall release this appropriation for immediate expenditure and encumbrance by the Department of
 Mental Health and Substance Abuse for the *I Famagu'on-ta* program.

3 Section 3. Appropriation to the Department of Education. The sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) is hereby appropriated from the 4 Unreserved Fund Balance of the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the 5 Department of Education for classroom supplies. This appropriation is not subject 6 to the Governor's transfer authority or the Bureau of Budget and Management 7 Research's allotment process. The Department of Administration shall release this 8 appropriation for immediate expenditure and encumbrance by the Department of 9 Education. 10

Section 4. Appropriation to the Mayors Council of Guam. 11 The sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) is hereby appropriated from the 12 Unreserved Fund Balance of the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the 13 Mayors Council of Guam for the upkeep and maintenance of public school 14 grounds. This appropriation is not subject to the Governor's transfer authority or 15 16 the Bureau of Budget and Management Research's allotment process. The Department of Administration shall release this appropriation for immediate 17 expenditure and encumbrance by the Mayors Council of Guam. 18

Section 5. Appropriation to the Department of Public Health and 19 The sum of Four Hundred Thirty-one Thousand Six Hundred Social Services. 20 Thirty-five Dollars (\$431,635) is hereby appropriated from the Unreserved Fund 21 Balance of the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the Department of Public 22 23 Health and Social Services to fund vacancies for nurses and other medical 24 professionals. This appropriation is not subject to the Governor's transfer authority or the Bureau of Budget and Management Research's allotment process. 25 The Department of Administration shall release this appropriation for immediate 26 expenditure and encumbrance by the Department of Public Health and Social 27 Services. 28

Section 6. Appropriation to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority. 1 2 The sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) is hereby appropriated to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for the purchase of linens, pillows and 3 patient gowns for the patients of the hospital. This appropriation is not subject to 4 the Governor's transfer authority or the Bureau of Budget and Management 5 Research's allotment process. The Department of Administration shall release this 6 appropriation for immediate expenditure and encumbrance by the Guam Memorial 7 Hospital Authority. 8

9 Section 7. Reporting Requirement. The Department of Administration
10 shall submit to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* monthly reports on the release of funds,
11 expenditures and encumbrances from appropriations made in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5,
12 and 6 of this Act.
