то AN ACT **RELATIVE** AVOIDING ANY UNNECESSARY **INTERRUPTION** OF **ESSENTIAL** HEALTHCARE SERVICES TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM THROUGH AUTHORIZING I MAGA'LAHEN GUAHAN TO GRANT A TEMPORARY MEDICAL LICENSE, WITH THE REVIEW AND CONSENT OF THE GUAM BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS, TO SPECIALIZED MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS WITH EQUIVALENT OR SIMILAR U.S. EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND **EXPERIENCE** LIMITED STANDARDS, FOR Α TEMPORARY THROUGH DECLARATION TIMEFRAME; OF Α HEALTHCARE EMERGENCY.

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that the people of Guam continue to require specialized medical treatment, i.e. cancer, etc, in which only 4 limited medical physicians are readily available on island to provide such 5 specialized healthcare services. In situations when all such specialized 6 medical physicians are not available to provide necessary treatment due to 7 illness or off-island activities, it is critical that such services be aggressively 8

sustained, and if necessary, I Maga'lahen Guahan be granted authorization
to recruit and retain such specialized physicians for a temporary timeframe
in an effort to avoid any unnecessary interruption in healthcare treatment
and services for the people of Guam.

Section 2. Temporary Limited Emergency Authorization for Acquisition of Specialized Medical Healthcare Services.

I Maga'lahen Guahan is hereby authorized to grant a limited 7 temporary emergency medical license, with the consent of the Guam Board 8 of Medical Examiners, to a specialized medical physician for a period not 9 to exceed Ninety (90) days to provide necessary healthcare treatment to the 10 people of Guam. The Guam Board of Medical Examiners shall be tasked to 11 review and validate the credentials of any physician who may be 12 considered for the emergency temporary license provided herein. Ι 13 Maga'lahen Guahan through an executive order shall identify the 14 emergency condition and stipulate the requirement for such temporary 15 specialized medical services, and highlight the medical professional who 16 will be granted said temporary medical license. The granting of an 17 emergency temporary medical license as detailed herein may provide for 18 the consideration of acceptable and equivalent medical education, training, 19 and experience in jurisdictions other than the United States and in a 20 medical facility which is equivalent to or exceeds U. S. nationally 21 acceptable healthcare standards. 22
