AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT CHAPTER 59 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT AND GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. The Memorandum of Agreement 3 (MOA) between the Guam Police Department (GPD) and the Guam International 4 Airport Authority (GIAA), currently in effect provides for the rental of GIAA 5 property by GPD at the rate of \$19,350.00 per month for a term up to September 6 30, 2011. The MOA provides for the administrative functions of the GPD on the 7 Tiyan property. The GPD is currently in arrears in its rental payment in the 8 amount of at least \$60,000.00 (as of December 2009). There appears to be no 9 immediate remedy available to resolve this issue. Moreover, GIAA has taken the 10 position that the Federal Aviation Administration will hold the government of 11 Guam to this MOA and failure to conform to the provisions contained within the 12 mentioned MOA will result in GIAA jeopardizing its ability to receive federal 13 funds and risk revocation of its international airport operations license. GIAA 14 has taken the position that the Federal Aviation Administration would not 15 support any usage of airport property by any other local government or private

1 entity unless the occupation of such airport property generates revenue for

2 GIAA.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the GIAA in the past served two notices to GPD for the government of Guam's arrears in ground rent payments to GIAA, the latest notice being on June 11, 2009 threatening legal action and eviction. A similar notice will most likely be served again to GPD for its repetitive failure to make rental payment in a timely manner.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the proposed construction for a public safety headquarters is timely, considering that the current MOA requires that "GPD shall commence the process of relocating from the Tiyan property and completely vacate the property by September 30, 2011, in order to allow GIAA to develop the property for aviation-related purposes." The MOA also provides that GPD will continue to downsize and reduce the amount of space it currently occupies, upon the execution of the MOA.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that due to a shortfall in government of Guam revenues, the government of Guam is unable at this time to make good on ground rent payments to GIAA.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the construction of a GPD Headquarters supported by dedicated funding sources would resolve this dilemma for Guam's premier law enforcement entity.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Fire Department (GFD) currently located at Suite 807, DNA Bldg., 238 Archbishop Flores St., Hagåtna, Guam occupies 4,826.19 S.F. at an annual cost of \$103,939.92 serves the Headquarters consisting of the Fire Chief's Office, Administrative Support Services, Training, Prevention, Internal Affairs and Safety. Additionally, the Supply Warehouse, E911 and Fire Dispatch formerly in Tiyan are sharing spaces

1	at the Fire Stations and Homeland Security. The Automotive/Heavy Equipment
2	Maintenance Pool is at the Department of Public Works.
3	I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that since its creation in 1985, GFD
4	Headquarters & administrative operations were housed at five different locations
5	in Hagåtna Pedro's Plaza, Sinajana Fire Station, Tiyan Housing, Tamuning Fire
6	Station and most recently at the DNA Building, Hagåtna. These locations and
7	office spaces were and are inappropriate and insufficient to maintain an efficient
8	and effective Headquarters Section, Training Section, Fire Prevention Bureau,
9	Supply and Logistics Section and E911 Center. These critical components of GFD
10	are all currently decentralized, and are also not consistent with the
l 1	recommendations of the National Fire Protection Association and the Office of
12	Homeland Security in establishing a secured and efficient life saving
13	infrastructure.
14	I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that GFD intends to centralize a Headquarters
15	Section, Training Section, Fire Prevention Bureau, Supply and Logistics Section
16	and E911 Communications Center in a safe and secure facility or facilities to
17	further improve services to the Island of Guam.
18	Therefore, I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to repeal and reenact Chapter 59
19	of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to authorize the building of a new
20	headquarters for both GPD and GFD, inclusive of dedicated funding sources
21	needed to facilitate these new construction projects.
22	Section 2. Chapter 59 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated is hereby
23	repealed and reenacted to read as follows:
24	"CHAPTER 59
25	THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT AND GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT
26	HEADQUARTERS
7	CONSTRUCTION INITIATIVE ACT OF 2000

§59101. Title. This Act shall be known as the Guam Police Department and Guam Fire Department Headquarters Construction Initiative of 2009.

§59102. Purpose. To authorize the construction of a new Guam Police Department (GPD) and Guam Fire Department (GFD) Headquarters which will benefit Guam's taxpayers in reducing rental cost and having ownership of a government facility by housing these related functions of GPD and GFD in a more centralized area to provide public services and meet the Territory of Guam's law enforcement and life safety missions. To establish, identify, and authorize revenue streams as a funding source to provide the needed revenue to secure a loan for the design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the new GPD and GFD Headquarters Building.

To also establish within the Territory of Guam an informal, cost effective and expeditious alternative to traditional petty misdemeanor and misdemeanor criminal proceedings. The procedures are intended to be voluntary on the part of those who have been charged with petty misdemeanor or misdemeanor offenses. At any time prior to the payment of the administrative penalty as provided on the administrative citation, the person charged may withdraw from participation in the procedures, in which event the Territory of Guam may bring criminal charges in accordance with the law and consistent with the underlying facts involved in the petty misdemeanor or misdemeanor citation. Likewise, the Territory of Guam may, without issuing an administrative citation, bring the appropriate criminal charges. In the event a party participates in the petty misdemeanor and misdemeanor procedures, but does not pay the monetary penalty specified on the administrative citation, the Territory of Guam may recover the costs entailed as part of a criminal disposition should the party charged be eventually adjudicated guilty of which shall be deposited in the GPD Headquarters Building Fund.

- To also establish a mechanism to utilize or authorize the use of any and all
- 2 funds generated by and for GFD, to secure a revenue source for the design,
- 3 construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the new GFD
- 4 Headquarters Building.
- 5 **§59103. Definitions.** The following terms wherever used or referred to in
- 6 this Act or in any indenture, lease or lease-back entered into pursuant hereto
- 7 (except to the extent modified therein in accordance with this Act) shall have the
- 8 following meanings, respectively, unless a different meaning appears from the
- 9 context:
- 10 (a)"Act" means the Guam Police Department and Guam Fire Department
- 11 Headquarters Construction Initiative of 2009.
- 12 (b) "Contractor" means the authorized entity which shall be the signatory
- on the lease and the lease-back and shall be fully responsible for carrying out the
- 14 financing, design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the
- 15 GPD and GFD headquarters facility. The contractor may cooperate with another
- 16 entity or entities in any manner the contractor deems appropriate to provide for
- 17 the financing, design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the
- 18 GPD and GFD Headquarters building.
- (c) "GPD" means Guam Police Department.
- 20 (d) "GFD" means Guam Fire Department.
- (e) "Departments" means both agencies.
- 22 (f) "Police Chief" means the Chief of Police, Guam Police Department.
- 23 (g) "Fire Chief" means the Fire Chief, Guam Fire Department.
- 24 (h) "Government" shall mean the government of Guam.
- 25 (i) "Public Safety Facility" shall mean GPD and GFD Headquarters
- 26 building structure or structures, together will all ancillary facilities, including

- 1 parking facilities, utilities, infrastructure and equipment associated with
- 2 providing the services required by a public safety agency. May include an
- 3 existing facility being converted or rehabilitated owned and/or operated by the
- 4 Departments or its contractors, agents or subcontractors, including, but not
- 5 limited to, appurtenant equipment such as electronic equipment, water tanks,
- 6 generators, and administrative facilities supporting the mission of GPD and
- 7 GFD, including facilities for payroll, billing and collections.
- 8 (j) "GPD Headquarters Building Fund" means Guam Police Department
- 9 Headquarters Building Fund by that name established pursuant to this Act.
- 10 (k) "GFD Headquarters Building Fund" means Guam Fire Department
- 11 Headquarters Building Fund by that name established pursuant to this Act.
- 12 (l) "Lease" means a ground or site lease of property from the Departments,
- or other government entity, or private property, as applicable, to the Contractor.
- (m) "Lease-back" means the facilities lease or other lease of the property
- 15 from the Contractor back to the Departments, over the term of which the costs of
- 16 the design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the Public
- 17 Safety Facility are amortized, according to the terms agreed to between the
- 18 Departments and the Contractor.
- 19 (n) "Pledged revenue" means any revenues identified within this Act
- 20 pledged to secure lease-back payments.
- 21 (o) "Property" means any property on which the Public Safety Facility is
- 22 located.
- 23 (p) "Revenue" of the project means all gross income and other amounts
- 24 received by or on behalf of the Departments as revenues identified within this
- 25 Act, including all increased rates, fees and charges received by the Departments
- and all proceeds of insurance or grants covering business interruption loss (and

1 related losses and expenses) relating to the project, and all other income and

2 revenue howsoever derived by the Departments from the ownership or

3 operation of, or arising from, the project, together with all interest, profits or

other income derived from the investment of amounts from revenues identified

within this Act, to be deposited, to GPD Headquarters Building Fund and GFD

6 Headquarters Building Fund in accordance with this Act.

§59104. Creation. There is hereby created, separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam, a reserve fund known as the "GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund".

§59105. Separate Fund and Bank Account. The GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund shall not be commingled with the General Fund or any other fund of the government of Guam. The GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund shall be exempted from the Governor's transfer authority and may not be borrowed against. The GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund shall be maintained in separate bank accounts.

§59106. Expenditures and Authorization to Construct. The GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund shall be expended for the design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the new Public Safety Facility, including, but not limited to, the following: A/E for the proposed building facility; environmental concerns; archeological and historic site survey and or assessment of the project site; site preparation and civil work for the building foundation; construction cost for the structure of the proposed building facility or any costs incurred by the Department of Public Works to be built within the Central area of the Territory of Guam.

§59107. Administration. The Chief of Police shall account for and administer the GPD Headquarters Building Fund. The Fire Chief shall account

1 for and administer the GFD Headquarters Building Fund. The Police Chief and

the Fire Chief shall keep all books, records, files and accounts relative to their

3 respective GPD Headquarters Building Fund and GFD Headquarters Building

4 Fund. Both Chiefs shall prepare monthly reports relative to their respective

5 Headquarters Building Fund reflecting the transactions and the financial

6 condition of their respective Headquarters Building Fund, which monthly

reports shall be transmitted to I Liheslaturan and I Maga 'lahen Guåhan.

§59108. Investment. The Chief of Police and the Fire Chief, together with the Director of Administration, may invest money held in the GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund in any type of investment approved for the Retirement Fund. All proceeds and income from investments of the GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund shall be respectively deposited in the GPD Headquarters Building Fund and GFD Headquarters Building Fund.

§59109. New GPD and GFD Headquarters Building. (a) GPD and GFD are hereby authorized to provide for the design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of a new public facility by entering into a financing arrangement with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, or other financing source, with lower cost of funds.

(b) Any financial arrangement to provide for the design, construction collateral equipment and maintenance of the Public Safety Facility shall be subject to the approval of the secured creditor of GPD and GFD. The Chief of Police and the Fire Chief, without jeopardizing existing obligations, is authorized to use a portion of its approved budget or other available funding sources, which shall be deposited into the GPD Headquarters Building Fund and GFD Headquarters Building Fund respectively, to make repayment and assure that its loan installments are paid on time; for emergency maintenance; for extensions to

- facilities; and for replacement of short-lived assets with a useful life significantly
- 2 less than the repayment period of any loan or the term, or any other financial
- 3 arrangement.
- 4 (c) Any monies reimbursed for expenses incurred on the design and
- 5 construction of the new Public Safety Facility shall revert to the GPD
- 6 Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund,
- 7 respectively.
- 8 (d) I Liheslaturan Guåhan authorizes I Maga'lahen Guåhan to indentify and
- 9 utilize any available funding sources to be designated as part of the GPD
- 10 Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund. I
- 11 Liheslaturan Guåhan encourages GPD and GFD to explore and identify any and
- 12 all potential financing sources or grants, including, but not limited to, any
- 13 Federal government instrumentalities or private financial lending sources, for
- 14 construction of the new Public Safety Facility.
- 15 (e) Interest derived from the financial agreement shall be exempt from
- taxation by the Government.
- 17 (f) Notwithstanding any substantive or procedural provision of Chapter 6
- of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the government of Guam hereby waives
- 19 immunity from any suit or action in contract on the loan, but does not waive
- 20 sovereign immunity as to personal liability of elected or appointed officials and
- 21 employees of the government of Guam."
- 22 (g) The proposed new Public Safety Facility shall be built or acquired
- 23 within the Central area of Guam specifically within the municipalities or
- 24 Hagatna, Tamuning, Barrigada, Mangilao, Sinajana, Agana Heights, and
- 25 Mongmong Toto Maite.
- 26 (h) In accordance with this Act, any available government of Guam
- 27 property that has been deem appropriate by the Department of Public Works for

- the site of this Project and/or private property (ies) identified by the lessor and concurred by the Department of Public Works may be designated as the official site for the Public Safety Facility.
- (i) Valid and Binding General Obligations. The financial instrument authorized by this Act shall constitute the valid and binding general obligations of the government of Guam. The government of Guam pledges its full faith and credit for the punctual payment of both principal of and interest on the financial instrument authorized by this Act.

- §59110. Creation of the Petty Misdemeanor and Misdemeanor Citation Procedures. GPD in collaboration with the Unified Judiciary of Guam and the Office of the Attorney General of Guam is hereby authorized to create and implement Rules and Regulations for the Petty Misdemeanor and Misdemeanor Citation Procedures subject to the Administrative Adjudication Act within 120 days from the date of the enactment of this Act.
- §59111. Red Light and Speed Electronic Camera System. Any funds generated from the issuance of traffic citations resulting from the incorporation of the red light and speed electronic camera system shall be obligated to the GPD Headquarters Building Fund. GPD may implement Rules and Regulations, subject to the Administrative Adjudication Act that may be needed to implement this Section.
- S59111.1 Traffic Citation Surcharge. All Traffic Citations issued shall have a 5% (five percent) surcharge of which shall be deposited into the GPD Headquarters Building Fund and shall be subject to the provisions of this Act.
 - §59112. Deposits. All monies generated from the Petty Misdemeanor and Misdemeanor Procedures, fees collected by the GPD, revenues collected from the red light and speed electronic camera system, and funds committed by I Maga'lahen Guåhan shall be deposited into the GPD Headquarters Building

- 1 Fund. All amounts deposited into the GPD Headquarters Building Fund shall be
- 2 solely for the purpose of paying debt service for the financing. All amounts in
- 3 the GPD Headquarters Building Fund on the 3rd day of each month after the
- 4 debt service have been made shall be paid by the Depositor to GPD for any
- 5 lawful purpose of GPD, free and clear of the pledge and lien of the Note,
- 6 Indenture, or other binding financing document.
- 7 §59113. Fees. Any fees collected by the GPD shall be deposited in the
- 8 GPD Headquarters Building Fund and shall be subject to the provisions of this
- 9 Act. Any fees collected by or designated for GFD shall be deposited into the
- 10 GFD Headquarters Building Fund and shall be subject to the provisions of this
- 11 Act.
- 12 **§59114.** *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* is hereby authorized to utilize any funding
- source within his/her oversight to commit to the GPD Headquarters Building
- 14 Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund. Such funds once committed
- shall be subject to the provisions of this Act.
- 16 §59115. Authorization to Enter into Long-Term Leases. I Maga'lahen
- 17 Guåhan may enter into a lease and lease-back on behalf of the Departments for
- 18 the financing of the acquisition, design, construction, improvement, equipping,
- 19 repair, renewal, replacement, or reconstruction of any GPD and/or GFD
- Headquarters building, together with maintenance of all or any portion of such
- 21 GPD and/or GFD Headquarters building over the term of the lease-back,
- according to the needs of the Departments and consistent with this Act.
- 23 The costs of the financing, design, construction, collateral equipment and
- 24 maintenance of a Public Safety Facility financed pursuant to this Act shall be
- amortized in periodic installments over the term of the lease-back period, which
- 26 shall be mutually determined by the Departments and the contractor. The lease
- 27 and lease-back may provide that if sufficient funds are not appropriated or

otherwise available for the payment of such installments, the Departments will 1 2 have the obligation to vacate the GPD and/or GFD Headquarters building, and 3 the contractor shall have the right of use and occupancy of the GPD and/or GFD headquarters building for the remainder of the term of the lease, unless new 4 5 mutually satisfactory terms are entered into. For this purpose, the lease may 6 provide that its term shall be extended for a period not to exceed the shorter of 7 ten (10) years beyond the original term of the lease-back or such period of time as 8 is necessary to repay in full any financing arranged pursuant to this Act. The 9 Departments shall pay the maintenance costs of the Public Safety Facility on a 10 periodic basis as incurred by the contractor on terms to be agreed to in the leaseback for the Public Safety Facility.

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It is hereby declared that the Public Safety Facility shall be a public improvement or undertaking as that term is used in Section 11 of the Organic Act (§ 1423a, Title 48, U.S. Code). Obligations incurred by the government pursuant to this Act that are payable only from funds in the GPD Headquarters Building Fund and the GFD Headquarters Building Fund available therefore and from revenue of the Public Safety Facility will not be and shall not be deemed to be public indebtedness of Guam as that term is used in said Section 11.

No obligation undertaken by the government pursuant to this Act shall be or become a lien, charge or liability against the government of Guam or against the Departments or against any property or funds of the government of Guam or the Departments, except to the extent of the pledge of revenue of the project provided by the lease-back.

§59116. Procurement. The government of Guam or the Departments may solicit Request for Proposals (RFP) through the Department of Public Works, in compliance with the Guam Procurement Law, for the financing, design 1 construction and collateral equipment of the Public Safety Facility, together with

2 the maintenance of the Public Safety Facility over the term of the lease-back,

according to the needs of the Departments and consistent with this Act.

§59117. Powers of Departments. Notwithstanding any provision of law or regulation, the Departments have powers and are hereby authorized, in addition to all other powers conferred upon the Departments or any other provision of this Chapter or by any law of Guam, to exercise any or all of the powers granted to the Departments by this Act.

§59118. Assignments. To facilitate the purposes of this Act and to provide security for the leaseholders, the contractor may assign, with the consent of the Departments, the lease and the lease-back to any trustee, underwriter or other appropriate party as may be necessary to facilitate the issuance of certificates of participation in lease-back payments or other financial instruments to provide the financing for the Public Safety Facility.

§59119. Use of Tax-Exempt Financing. To minimize the financing cost to the Departments, all financing utilized by the contractor to fund the design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the Public Safety Facility shall be through tax-exempt obligations, if a mechanism to do so is available. The purpose for this requirement is to assure that the Departments pays the lowest possible interest rate so that the cost of financing the design, construction, collateral equipment and maintenance of the Public Safety Facility to the Departments, amortized through the lease-back payments from the Departments to the contractor, will be lower than regular commercial rates.

§59120. Lease-Back May be Secured Funding. The Lease-Back may be secured by the funding sources identified within this Act as the Petty Misdemeanor and Misdemeanor Citations, any and all Fees collected by the GPD

as authorized by law, all revenues derived from the collection of traffic citations generated from red light and speed electronic camera systems, 5% traffic citation surcharge, and other revenue sources within I Maga'lahen Guåhan discretionary oversight, any and all Fees collected by or designated by GFD as provided by this Act. A lease-back shall provide that payment of obligations hereunder may be secured by a pledge of and lien upon all or any portion of the revenues mentioned herein, subject to any parity lien created pursuant to this Act. Any such pledge and lien shall be valid and binding from the time the pledge is made. The revenues pledged and thereafter received by the government or by any trustee, depository or custodian shall be deposited in the respective GPD Headquarters Building Fund and GFD Headquarters Building Fund accounts and shall be immediately subject to the lien of such pledge without any physical delivery thereof or further act, and the lien of such pledge shall be valid and binding against all parties having claims of any kind in tort, contract or otherwise, against the government or such trustee, depository or custodian, irrespective of whether the parties have notice thereof. The instrument by which such pledge is created need not be recorded, except to the extent that such instrument conveys an interest in land or improvements thereon.

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§59121. Approval of Bonds. *I Liheslaturan Guahan*, pursuant to Title 12 GCA §50103(k), hereby approves the issuance and sale by the Departments and the government of Guam of bonds for the purposes mandated by this Act; *provided* that the bonds are issued and sold subject to the requirements and limitations mandated therein.

§59122. Responsibility of Contractor. The lease-back shall require that the contractor be responsible for all costs, expenses and fees of any kind or nature, associated with the improvements, on-site infrastructure and off-site infrastructure, construction, permits and financing associated with the

- 1 completion of the Public Safety Facility, including the financing of furniture and
- 2 equipment for the Public Safety Facility, as and to the extent provided by the
- 3 Departments in the RFP. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the capital
- 4 maintenance of the Public Safety Facility building during the term of the lease-
- 5 back.
- 6 §59123 Utilities and Routine Maintenance and Repair. The Contractor
- 7 shall be responsible for the connection and payment of all utilities, including
- 8 without limitation, power, water, sewer, telephone and cable, and all routine
- 9 interior maintenance and repair and exterior grounds keeping and landscaping
- and upkeep of the Public Safety Facility. Capital maintenance and repair shall be
- 11 performed by Contractor as provided for in this Act.
- 12 **§59124. No Personal Liability.** Neither *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*, the Chiefs,
- any employee of the Departments, any employee of the government nor any
- 14 elected official of the government shall be individually or personally liable for
- 15 the payment of any amounts due under any lease or lease-back, or for any other
- liability arising in connection with a lease or lease-back; provided, however, that
- 17 nothing in this Act, shall relieve any employee or elected official from the
- 18 performance of any ministerial duty required by law.
- 19 §59125. Rules, Regulations, and Restrictions. The Departments and the
- 20 Department of Public Works may promulgate rules and regulations pursuant to
- 21 Guam law necessary to implement the provisions of this Act.
- 22 **§59126. Construction of Act.** This Act shall be liberally construed to carry
- out the objects and purposes and the declared policy of the government of Guam
- 24 as in this Article set forth. Nothing contained in this Act shall be construed
- 25 directly or by implication to be in any way in derogation or limitation of powers
- conferred upon or existing in the Departments, the Chiefs or I Maga'lahen Guåhan
- 27 by virtue of any provisions of the Organic Act or laws of Guam.

Resident Commissioner or Governors Office or Lieutenant Governor's Office, members of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, advisor, consultants or employees of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* or Employees of the Government of Guam and their relatives or immediate family members, shall be admitted to any share or part of the contract for the project or to any benefit that may arise there from, but this provision shall not be construed to extend to the contract for the project if made with a corporations for its general benefit.

No official of the Owner who is authorized in such capacity and on behalf of the Owner to negotiate, make, accept or approve, or to take part in negotiating, making, accepting, or approving any architectural, engineering, inspection, construction or material supply contract or any subcontract in connection with the construction of the project, shall become directly or indirectly interested personally in the contract for the project or in any part hereof. No officer, employee, architect, attorney, engineer, or inspector of or for the Government of Guam authorized to exercise any legislative, executive supervisory or other similar functions in connection with the construction of the project, shall become directly or indirectly interested personally in this contract or in any part thereof, any material supply contract, subcontract, insurance contract, or other contract pertaining to this project.

§59128. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
