AN ACT TO AMEND §7120.3 TO CHAPTER 7, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE INCLUSION OF SPOUSES, WIDOWS AND WIDOWERS IN THE ELIGIBILITY FOR ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL GOLD STAR LICENSE PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 2. A new §7120.3, Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
- 3 amended to read:

- 4 "§7120.3. Special Gold Star License Plates. (a) The Motor
- 5 Vehicle Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation shall, upon
- 6 application, issue gold star license plates. The type and style of the gold star
- 7 plates shall be determined by the Director of the Department of Revenue and
- 8 Taxation and the Office of Veterans Affairs, except that a gold star *shall*
- 9 appear on one (1) side of the plate. Applicants *shall* apply on forms
- 10 prescribed by the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation, and
- the applicant's eligibility will be certified by the Office of Veterans Affairs.

The plates shall be re-issued only to the original holder of the plates. The 12 Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation may adopt rules to 13 implement the provisions of this Section. Except for a new or renewed 14 registration, applications for the issuance of gold star plates shall be 15 processed in the order received by the Department subject to normal 16 workflow considerations. The fee for the issuance of gold star plates shall 17 not exceed the fee charged for a similar license plate for the same class of 18 vehicle. 19 (b) Eligibility for Issuance. Gold Star License Plates shall only be 20 21 issued to parents, inclusive of mother, father, stepmother, stepfather, and mother through adoption, father through adoption, and foster parents who 22 stood in loco parentis of members of the armed services, spouses, widows and
