AN ACT TO STIFFEN THE PENALTY IMPOSED FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE HOURS OF SALE PROVISION OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL LAW BY AMENDING § 3613 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 3613 of Chapter 3 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated is
hereby *amended* to read:

"§ 3613. Same: Hearing, Penalties for Licensees.

5 (a) The Board upon receipt of the report required in §3612 *shall*, as
6 soon as practicable, hold a hearing on such report.

7 (b) The Board *shall* impose a penalty on a licensee found guilty of 8 violating any of the provisions of this Chapter amounting to Seven Hundred 9 Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for the first offense; One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for the second offense; Two Thousand Five Hundred 10 Dollars (\$2,500.00) for the third offense; and Three Thousand Five Hundred 11 12 Dollars (\$3,500.00) for the fourth offense. After the fourth offense, the Board may impose a penalty of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 13 (\$4,500.00) and a forty-eight (48) hour suspension for every subsequent 14 offense. Contingent on the severity of any violation, the Board may use its 15

discretion and suspend or revoke the license of any licensee found guilty of
 violating any of the provisions of this Chapter.
