AN ACT TO AMEND §60112 ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 2 OF CHAPTER 60, 21 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE LAND FOR THE LANDLESS PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 1

Section 1. Section 60112, Article 1, Division 2 of Chapter 60, 21 2

Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read as follows:

"\$60112. Legislative Approval Required. Notwithstanding any 4

other provisions of law, government-owned real property shall not be sold, 5

leased, sub-leased, exchanged or otherwise transferred without the prior

approval of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) by duly enacted legislation, which

specifically authorizes a particular sale, lease, exchange or transfer and

9 includes the real property description of the government-owned real property

with particularity. This Section shall not apply to Land Use Permits, Land 10

11 for the Landless Program or residential leases by the, Chamorro Land Trust

Commission pursuant to its rules and regulations, but *shall* apply to any 12

transfer to the federal government or any agent of the federal government of

land owned in the name of the government of Guam, including, but not 14

limited to, its autonomous agencies, public corporations, the Chamorro Land

Trust Commission and the Ancestral Lands Commission." 16

- Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.
- Section 3. Severability. If any provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
