AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 8A TO TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED REQUIRING THAT ALL NOTICES PAID FOR BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM SHALL BE ISSUED IN BOTH CHAMORRO AND ENGLISH.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Chapter 8A is hereby *added* to Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read follows:

9 §8A104. Severability.

§8A101. Title. This Act may be cited or referred to as "The Chamorro and English Notice Requirement Act of 2010."

§8A102. Policy. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby establishes that it shall be the policy of the government of Guam to provide adequate public notice(s) of any and all meetings of the government in both the English and Chamorro languages. Such notice shall be issued in both Chamorro and

English for publication in a newspaper of general circulation a reasonable time prior to the date of the scheduled meeting or hearing.

- §8A103. Requirement. (a) Regular Meetings. Any public agency which holds a meeting required by statute, regulation or resolution, shall give five (5) working days public notice, and a second public notice at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the start of the meeting. The public notice shall be issued and printed both in Chamorro and English.
- (b) Special Meetings. Any public agency which holds a meeting not previously scheduled by statute, regulation or resolution, or for which notice is not already provided by law, shall give five (5) working days public notice of such meeting, and a second notice at least forty-eight (48) hours, prior to the start of such meeting as required by this Chapter. The public notice shall be issued and printed both in Chamorro and English.
- (c) Public Service Announcements. All Public Service Announcements (psa) initiated by any public agency, shall be issued and printed both in Chamorro and English.
- (d) ADA Requirements. The public agency must comply with provisions of Title II of the ADA requirements for effective communication for people with disabilities and include information in the notice that individuals requiring special accommodations, auxiliary aids or services shall contact and submit their request to the designated agency or department representative or ADA Coordinator. The public agency shall make available the name, office address and telephone number, including TDD, of the designated ADA Coordinator.
- **(e) In Addition.** The Chamorro and English notice requirements shall be in addition to and not in substitution of any other notice required by law.

§8A104. Severability. *If* any provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this law are severable."
