AN ACT TO INCLUDE THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE ABUSE IN THE GROUP PURCHASING OF DRUGS WITH OTHER AGENCIES; BY AMENDING §5270 OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, - SO AS TO INCLUDE DMHSA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Finding and Intent: I Liheslaturan Guahan 8 finds that the Department of Mental Health & Substance Abuse is unable to 9 take advantage of wholesale purchase prices in the acquisition of 10 pharmaceuticals along with the Department of Administration, the 11 Department of Public Health & Social Services, the Guam Memorial 12 Hospital Authority, and the Department of Education, because they are not 13 included in §5270, of Article 4, Chapter 4, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated – 14 Government to Purchase Drugs from Manufacturer. This is resulting in 15 DMH&SA paying higher prices for the same pharmaceuticals being 16 procured in group purchases by other government of Guam agencies. 17

It is the *intent* of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to include the Department of Mental Health & Substance Abuse, by amending §5270, of Article 4,

- 1 Chapter 4, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated Government to Purchase Drugs
- 2 from Manufacturer.
- Section 2. Section §5270 of Article 4, Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code
- 4 Annotated, is amended, to read:
- 5 "§ 5270. Government to Purchase Drugs from Manufacturer.
- 6 Whenever possible, the Department of Administration, the
- 7 Department of Public Health and Social Services, the Guam
- 8 Memorial Hospital Authority, the Department of Mental Health &
- 9 <u>Substance Abuse</u>, and the Department of Education shall purchase
- drugs, generic or other wise, directly from the manufacturer so as to
- ensure and maximize economy."
