

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 17 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Findings and Intent.

Subsequent to §12121 of Public Law 29-140, the Guam Academy Charter Schools Council is required to submit recommendations to *I Liheslatura* within thirty days of its first meeting at which a quorum is present. In compliance with its legislative mandate, the Council has found significant issues that it believes *I Liheslatura* should promptly address in order to guarantee that the creation and operation of charter schools on Guam is efficiently and effectively successful with minimal concerns. *I Liheslatura* finds that the recommendations submitted by the Guam Academy Charter Schools Council is within reason and further amends provisions within its enabling act to provide a proficient approach to the operations of Charter Schools on the island.

Section 2. Subsection (g) is hereby *added* to §12103 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated to read:

- "(g) Appeal Board means the ad hoc Appeals Board composed of the Public Auditor, the Attorney General, the President of the Guam Community College, the President of the University of Guam, and the Superintendent of the Guam Department of Education."
- **Section 3.** Subsection (a) of §12106 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"(a) Schedule. An eligible applicant seeking to establish an Academy Charter School *shall* submit a petition pursuant to §12105 of this Chapter to the Council *no later than* the first Monday of January August. However, it is recommended that an eligible applicant consult with the Council prior to submitting the petition. All petitions submitted *no later than* the first Monday in January August *shall* be for the following school year. The deadline to submit a petition to establish a non-converted public school into an Academy Charter School *or* convert a public elementary school into an Academy Charter School for the School Year 2010-2011 *shall* be March 8, 2010."

Section 4. Subsection (e) of §12106 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"(e) The Council *shall* approve *or* deny a petition to establish an Academy Charter School *not later than* thirty (30) sixty (60) days after the conclusion of the public hearing on the petition."

Section 5. Subsection (f) of §12106 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"(f) Denial explanation. Written notice of the council's action *shall* be sent to the eligible applicant. IF the petition is *not* approved, the reasons for the denial and suggested remedial measures, *if* any, *shall* be clearly stated in the notice sent by the council to the eligible applicant. *If* the petition is *not* approved, the eligible applicant may amend the petition to address objections and any suggested remedial measures and resubmit the petition to the Council. The Council *shall* approve *or* disapprove the resubmitted petition within twenty (20) days after receiving it. *If* the petition is *not* approved, the eligible applicant may appeal the decision of the Council to the <u>Appeal Board</u>."

Section 6. Subsection (e) of §12111 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"(e) Clerical and administrative support *shall* be provided by the Department of Education Guam Certification Office."

3	"(f) The Counsel shall utilize the Office of the Attorney General of Guam as
4	its legal counsel, unless the Attorney General, in writing, authorizes the Council to

7	hereby amended to read:
8	"(3) shall ensure monitor that each such Academy Charter School complies
9	with applicable laws and the provisions of the charter granted to such school;"
10	Section 9. Subsection (a)(5) of §12112 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is
11	hereby amended to read:
12	"(5) shall ensure monitor that each Academy Charter School complies with
13	the annual reporting requirements, including, submission of the audited financial
14	statement."
15	Section 10. Subsection (f) is hereby added to §12112 of Title 17 of the Guam Code
16	Annotated to read:
17	"(f) The Council shall promulgate Administrative Rules and Regulations
18	consistent with the provisions of Title 5, GCA, Chapter 9. Such Rules and
19	Regulations may be revised as needed consistent with the provisions of Title 5,
20	GCA, Chapter 9."
21	Section 11. Subsection (a) of §12113 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is
22	hereby amended to read:
23	"(a) A Charter granted to an Academy Charter School shall remain in force for
24	a five (5) year period, unless revoked as authorized in §12114 of this Chapter."
25	Section 12. Subsection (k) of §12113 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is
26	hereby amended to read:
27	"(k) A decision not to renew the Charter of an Academy Charter School may
28	be appealed to the Appeal Board as described by § 12115 of this Chapter."

- **Section 13.** Subsection (f) of §12114 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:
- "(f) *If* the Academy Charter's School Charter is revoked, the Trustees *may*appeal the decision of the Council to the <u>Appeal</u> Board."
 - **Section 14.** §12115 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"§ 12115. Appeal Process.

- (a) The <u>Appeal</u> Board, upon receipt of a notice of appeal, *shall* review the decision of the Council.
- (b) An eligible applicant or the Trustees of an Academy Charter School that wishes to appeal a decision of the Council concerning the denial, nonrenewal or revocation of an Academy Charter School shall provide the Appeal Board with a notice of appeal within thirty (30) days after the Council's decision. The eligible applicant or Trustees of the Charter School bringing the appeal shall limit the grounds of the appeal to the grounds for denial, nonrenewal or revocation specified by the Council. The notice *shall* include a brief statement of the reasons the eligible applicant or Trustees contends the Council's decision was in error. Within thirty days (30) after receipt of the notice of appeal, the Appeal Board shall hold a public hearing that may be held in the school district in which the proposed Academy Charter School has applied for or at the current location of the Academy Charter School. The Appeal Board shall review the decision of the Council and make its findings within ten (10) days after the completion of the public hearing. If the Appeal Board finds that the Council's decision was contrary to the best interests of the students, or community, the Appeal Board shall reverse the decision of the Council. The decision of the <u>Appeal</u> Board shall be final and not subject to appeal."
- **Section 15.** Subsection (b) of §12116 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:
 - "(b) The Council *shall* submit on a timely basis as required by the Board, the budgets of an Academy Charter Schools to the Superintendent of Education. The

l	Superintendent of Education shall submit the budgets to the Board for approval for
2	submission to I Liheslatura as part of the Department of Education Fiscal Year
3	Budget."

Section 16. §12118 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"§ 12118. Academic Credits; Transfer.

If a student who was previously enrolled in an Academy Charter School enrolls in a public school, the public school shall accept credits earned by the student in courses *or* instructional programs at the Academy Charter School in a uniform and consistent manner and according to the same criteria that are used to accept academic credits from other public schools. This reciprocity of acceptance for transfers of academic credits shall apply to students previously enrolled in a public school who enrolls in an Academy Charter School and students previously enrolled in an Academy Charter School who enrolls in another Academy Charter School."

Section 17. §12120 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *repealed*.
