AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT § 30101 AND TO REPEAL § 30101.1, BOTH OF CHAPTER 30, DIVISION 3 OF TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AND TO AMEND § 6112 OF CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE 3 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE SELECTION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM**

2 **Section 1.** § 30101 of Chapter 30 of Title 5 of the Guam Code
3 Annotated is hereby *repealed and re-enacted* to read:

4 **“§ 30101. Attorney General.**

5 (a) The Office of the Attorney General of the Government of
6 Guam shall be administered by the Attorney General of Guam, who
7 shall be appointed by the Governor for a term of four (4) years, or
8 until the end of the term of the appointing governor, whichever is
9 sooner, with the advise and consent of the Legislature. The Governor
10 may remove the Attorney General for cause.”

11 **Section 2.** § 30101.1 of Chapter 30 of Title 5 of the Guam Code
12 Annotated is hereby *repealed*.

1 **Section 3.** § 6112 of Chapter 6 of Title 3 of the Guam Code
2 Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

3 **“§ 6112. Filing and Distribution of Petitions.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, candidates for *I*
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* [Guam Legislature], offices of *I Maga'lahren*
6 *Guåhan* [Governor] and *I Segundu Na Maga'lahren Guåhan*
7 [Lieutenant Governor], Washington Delegate, Mayor and Vice-
8 Mayor, and the Public Auditor ~~and the Attorney General~~ shall file
9 their declarations of candidacy with the Commission no earlier than
10 one hundred and thirty (130) days before the primary election, and no
11 later than sixty (60) days before the primary election. Notwithstanding
12 any other provision of law, candidates for the Guam Education Policy
13 Board, and the Consolidated Commission on Utilities shall file their
14 declarations of candidacy with the Commission no earlier than one
15 hundred and thirty (130) days and no later than sixty (60) days before
16 the general election. The Commission shall publish in a newspaper of
17 general circulation the names of all candidates and the offices for
18 which they have declared their candidacy after each filing deadline.”

19 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon
20 enactment.
