AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7 OF CHAPTER 7 OF P.L.
30-55 RELATIVE TO GROUNDS MAINTENANCE FOR THE
PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 7 of Chapter 7 of P.L. 30-55 is hereby amended to read as
3 follows:

4 **“Section 7. Grounds Maintenance for School.** Subject to approval and
5 scheduling of the public school principals, the Mayors are responsible for the
6 eighteen (18) cuts of regular grounds maintenance of DOE school grounds in their
7 respective districts where ground maintenance is *not* already subject to an existing
8 contract. Subject to approval of scheduling with the public school principals, the
9 Mayor may contract with a private entity to provide the services authorized by this
10 Section.

11 The sum of ~~Four Hundred Eighty Thousand Six Hundred Forty seven~~
12 ~~Dollars (\$480,647)~~ Four Hundred Seventy-four Thousand Seven Hundred twenty
13 (\$474,720) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Community Development
14 Fund for the grounds maintenance of specified schools of the Department of
15 Education below to be allocated as follows:
