**AN ACT TO AMEND §51202(A) OF TITLE 10 OF THE
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED AND TO AMEND
§3401.1. (H)(4) OF TITLE 16 OF THE GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEMENT
OF LITTER CONTROL LAWS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. §51202(a) of Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated is amended**
3 **to read as follows:**

4 **§51202. Definitions.**

5 (a) Apprehending Officers shall mean any designated individual with
6 the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Department of Agriculture,
7 the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Public
8 Health and Social Services, the Department of Public Works, all village
9 Mayors and assistant mayors, and any peace officer and volunteers as
10 described in §3401.1. (h) of Title 16 GCA in the Guam Police
11 Department.

12 **Section 2. §3401.1. (h)(4) of Title 16 of the Guam Code Annotated is**
13 **amended to read as follows:**

14 (4) obtain a certificate from the Chief of Police demonstrating

1 the completion of a required course of instruction and training that
2 includes training in measures to avoid dangerous confrontations
3 with violators of this Section. In addition training shall include the
4 enforcement of litter control laws. The course of instruction and training
5 shall be at no cost to the volunteer. Retired “uniformed personnel” are
6 exempted from this subsection; and
