AN ACT TO AMEND §1013 OF TITLE 1, OF THE
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
DELEGATING ALL LIBERATION FESTIVITIES TO
THE MAYOR'S COUNCIL OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. §1013 of Chapter 10 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated is
3 hereby *amended* to read:

4 "§1013. Guam Island Fair Committee.

5 The ~~Governor~~ Mayor's Council of Guam is authorized and
6 requested to annually appoint a Guam Island Fair Committee to plan
7 and make appropriate arrangements for the celebration of this Fair. The
8 Committee shall be composed of members of patriotic, religious, or
9 other civic organizations. In lieu of such Committee, the ~~Governor~~
10 Mayor's Council of Guam may designate one or more such civic
11 organizations as sponsors to plan and arrange for the Fair.

12 All net proceeds shall be donated to a worthy public cause or
13 causes as the committee or the sponsoring organization(s), as the case
14 may be, determine.

15 The government may furnish a suitable site, if needed, but neither
16 it nor any agencies, instrumentalities, nor employees may otherwise

1 participate in the planning and preparation for the Island Fair during
2 work hours or use government supplies or equipment; provided, that
3 employees or participating departments or agencies may be given a
4 limited time to prepare departmental or agency floats for the designated
5 parades. Unless appropriated by the Legislature, or approve by the
6 governing board of applicable autonomous agencies, no government
7 funds or materials shall be used in the preparation of these floats.”
