

**AN ACT TO FACILITATE THE EXPEDITIOUS ISSUANCE OF  
GENERAL OPERATORS DRIVERS LICENSES, THROUGH  
THE PROVISION OF OFF-DUTY ROAD EXAMINATIONS  
FOR LICENSE ENDORSEMENT "A" CLASS LICENSES, BY  
AMENDING SUBSECTION (uu) OF §1102 OF CHAPTER 1,  
TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent:** *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds  
3 that the procedure of applying for a non-commercial motor vehicle driver's license  
4 has become a tedious process in that the Motor Vehicle Division of the Department  
5 of Revenue & Taxation is understaffed and unable to keep pace with the ever  
6 increasing demand. The Motor Vehicle Division administers approximately four  
7 hundred (400) written tests every testing cycle, which is conducted by the  
8 University of Guam every two (2) weeks. The backlog lays in the conduct of road  
9 tests for applicants. Currently, the waiting period for a road test is approximately  
10 six (6) months. Just as P.L. 30-140 was enacted for the purpose of expediting the  
11 issuance of commercial motor vehicle operators' licenses by way of providing for  
12 the off-duty conduct of road tests on weekends and holidays, it is likewise  
13 appropriate that these accommodations be made for non-commercial applicants  
14 seeking a motor vehicle operators' License Endorsement "A" category license.

1           It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* that the Department of Revenue &  
2 Taxation shall be authorized to administer “off-duty” road examinations for  
3 Operators License Endorsement “A” category licenses.

4           **Section 3.** The Department of Revenue & Taxation shall be authorized to  
5 administer “off-duty” road examinations for Operators License Endorsement “A”  
6 category licenses.

7           **Section 3.** A Subsection (uu) of §1102, Chapter 1, Title 16, Guam Code  
8 Annotated, is hereby amended, to read:

          “(uu) *Services* means Operators License Endorsement A, and  
Chauffeurs License Endorsement B, C, D and G road examinations.”

9           **Section 4.** This Act shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
