3        **WHEREAS, CW5 Francis A. Pablo, is married to Margarita M. Pablo of**  
4        **Panama, Central America, and they have four (4) beautiful sons, Francis,**

1           **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo, was born and raised in the village of  
2 Mongmong, where he lived for over nineteen (19) years, and presently resides  
3 in the village of Barrigada, where he has lived for over twenty-two (22) years;

6 of active duty military service, which includes service in the regular Army;

10 School from 1975 to 1977 and graduated from George Washington High  
11 School in 1978. He attended the University of Guam for one (1) semester and  
12 then joined the regular Army under the Delayed Entry program; and

13           **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo, served in various duty assignments  
14 and capacities, to include: Chief Evaluation Section, Chief Board Section, and  
15 Chief Warrant Officer Policy/Regulation Branch at the National Guard  
16 Bureau; and

17           **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo, has been involved with different  
18 associations and organizations, including: Treasurer and President for the  
19 Warrant Officer Association Chapter in Virginia; member of the National  
20 Guard Association of the United States; and a parish council member for the  
21 Toto Catholic Church; and

1           **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo continued furthering his education  
2 obtaining his Associates Degree in General Studies and Associates Degree in  
3 Applied Science in Management, both at Central Texas College, earning one  
4 hundred eighty-nine (189) credits from the American Council on Education,  
5 and is enrolled with Excelsior College, Albany New York, pursuing a  
6 Bachelor of Science Degree in Management on Human Resources; and


7           **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo, has completed numerous military


